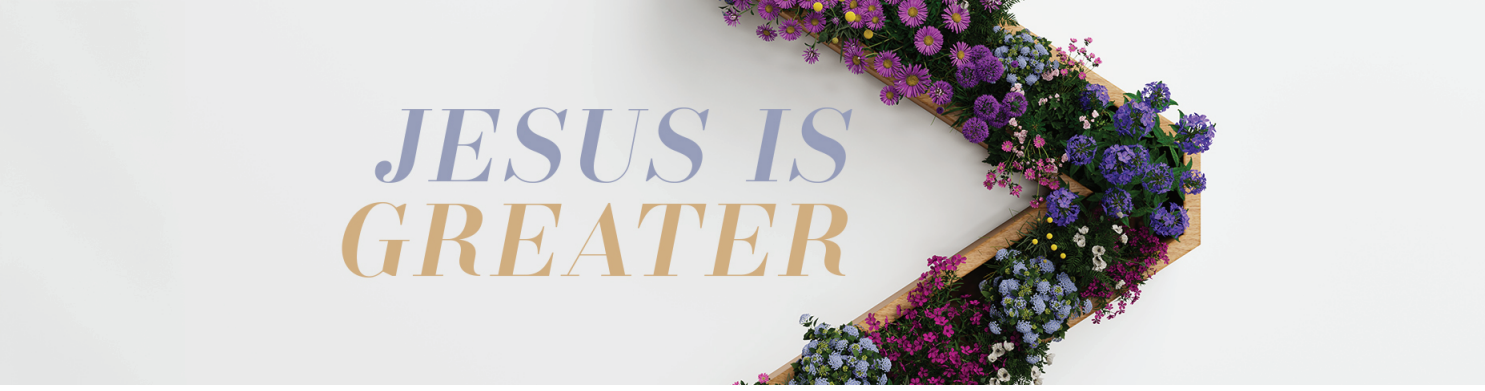




JESUS IS GREATER

INTRODUCTION

3. Paul's response to skepticism was to share his personal encounter with Jesus. How effective do you think this approach is compared to presenting historical evidence?
4. The sermon states, "Nobody dies for something they know is a hoax." How does this argument support the authenticity of the disciples' testimony about the resurrection?
5. Agrippa's response was "almost persuaded." What do you think holds people back from fully embracing faith in Jesus?
6. How has your own journey of faith been similar to or different from Paul's dramatic conversion experience?
7. What was your biggest takeaway from the message, and why?
