WHAT TO BRING TO BEACH CAMP 2026

- o Flip-flops/crocs/chacos/slides for the showers, beach, and pools
- o Light weight rain jacket (Just in case)
- o Items for the beach (frisbee, volleyball, etc.)
- o Reusable water bottle
- o Closed toe shoes for rec time
- o Flashlights (for Church Time on the beach)
- o Spending money for Lunch x3, souvenirs, the ice cream/coffee shoppe at Laguna Beach.

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO BEACH CAMP 2026

- o "Short" shorts or skirts
- o Tight clothing
- o Halter, tube or spaghetti strap tops
- o TVs or gaming systems
- o Tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs
- o Fireworks of any nature
- o Weapons of any kind (guns, knives, etc.)
- o STUFF for pranks (Fart spray, shaving cream fights, water balloons, squirt guns etc.)
- o Clothing with questionable or inappropriate slogans, images, etc.
- o Clothing that promotes alcohol, tobacco, or inappropriate items
- o Anything else that would be a distraction for your group or other churches



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT TO BRING: Bed linens (Bunk beds twin, or a sleeping bag), pillow, towels, toiletries, sunscreen, notebook, and Bible.

CHARTER BUS: We will be traveling on a 55-passenger charter bus.

SECONDARY TRANSPORTATION: We will also have passenger vehicles available for supply runs or emergencies.

REGISTERED NURSE: We will also have a registered nurse available if needed but hopefully not.

TRIBE WARS: For Tribe Wars, this year Lakeside is on the YELLOW team! If you are new to STS Camp, Tribe Wars are just camp games where teams compete for the most points. Our camp shirts are green to correspond with our tribe color. So, bring some yellow apparel to support our tribe.

THEME NIGHTS: Theme nights are opportunities to have some fun and dress up. This year is as follows (participation is optional of course):

- Friday night: CAMO
- Saturday night: SPACE
- Sunday night: TRIBE COLOR YELLOW

HOUSING: We will be staying in dormitory style house/units with bunk beds with private bathroom facilities with plenty of hot water.

RECREATION: Some REC time is scheduled by the camp. Basketball, volleyball, and gaga ball courts are located throughout the campus. Volleyballs and basketballs are provided. The camp also has 11 swimming pools.

MEALS: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner is provided and prepared in large fully equipped kitchen. The camp also has Laguna Beach Grill and Laguna Beach Coffee & Cream restaurants open throughout the day.

SNACKS: Lakeside will be providing enough snacks to last throughout the weekend.
