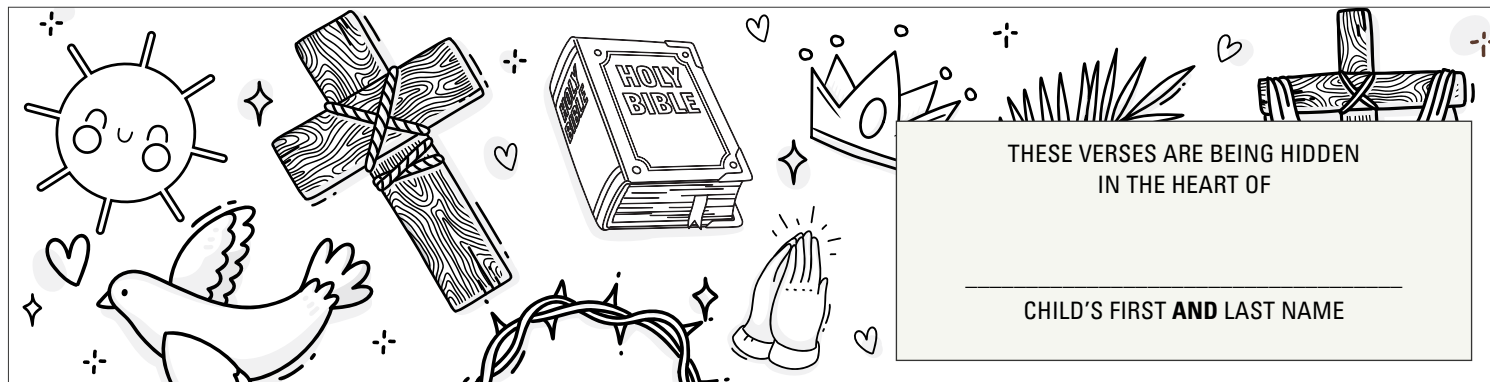

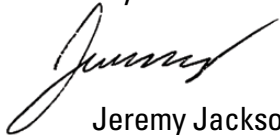
Dear Parents,

The importance of hiding the word of God in our hearts cannot be overemphasized. Jesus said, "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God" (Matt 4:4). God's word alone gives the wisdom that leads to salvation. (2 Tim 3:15). It is the word of God that makes the man of God "adequate, equipped for every good work" (2 Tim 3:17). Because God works through His Word, we encourage families of all ages to memorize God's Holy Word with the children.

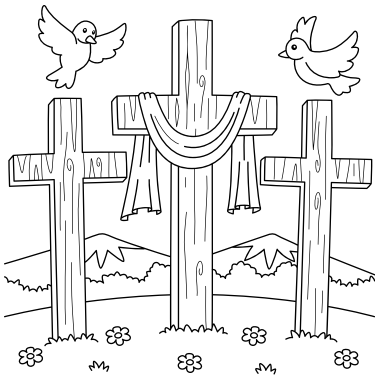
You will note that along with Scripture memory, we will also be memorizing a catechism this year. A catechism is a summary of the truths of Christ in the form of questions and answers. We will have shorter portions of the catechism and verse passage in age-appropriate lengths. The youngest children (3-4-year-olds) will memorize one verse and Q&A per month; the bold section, young children (K - 1st grade), will memorize the underlined part of the catechism and verse passage. And the older children, parents, grandparents, and anyone else will memorize the entire catechism and verse passage.

I know the prayer of every Christian parent is to see their children come to know the Lord Jesus Christ in a personal saving way. May God use these verses and catechism questions and answers, not only to save them, but to equip them so that they will be a pillar and support of the truth in the coming generation.
