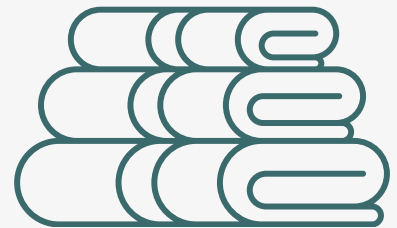



# POLICY AND PROCEDURES

## CODE OF CONDUCT

### ***AS A CAMPER, I WILL:***

- BE RESPECTFUL, COOPERATIVE, POSITIVE TO OTHER CAMPERS.
- BE CAREFUL AND CONSIDERATE THAT MY ACTIONS WILL NOT HURT ANOTHER CAMPER'S FEELINGS OR HURT THEM PHYSICALLY, EITHER INTENTIONALLY OR ACCIDENTALLY.
- SHOW RESPECT TO THE CAMP STAFF, AND COOPERATE FULLY WITH THEIR INSTRUCTIONS.
- RESPECT THE CAMP PROPERTY AND THE PROPERTY OF OTHERS.
- CONDUCT MYSELF RESPONSIBLY. I UNDERSTAND THAT HORSEPLAY, INAPPROPRIATE TOUCHING, UNWELCOME TEASING/BULLYING OR ANY UNKIND BEHAVIOR IS NOT ALLOWED AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
- CAMPERS WILL FOLLOW THE SAFETY RULES FOR EACH ACTIVITY THAT HE/SHE PARTICIPATES IN WHILE AT CAMP.
- CAMPERS ARE EXPECTED TO FOLLOWING THE DRESS CODE.
- CELL PHONES ARE ONLY PERMITTED FOR EMERGENCY USE ONLY OR WITH APPROVAL FROM CAMP STAFF.

# DRESS CODE



- At anytime we feel as if clothing is seen as inappropriate we will ask your child to change. We ask that you follow "school dress code".

- Sleeveless shirts must extend all the way to the shoulder seam.
- Undergarments must always be covered by outer garments.
- No racer or criss-cross backs.



- Shorts need to be fingertip length.
- Tights/leggings are not allowed.

- Girls must wear a one-piece.
- Boys and Girls must wear a t-shirt and shorts to and from the pool.
- If you do not have a one-piece, please wear a dark shirt over your two-piece.
- Boys do not have to wear a t-shirt to swim.



- Closed toed and closed heel shoes are required!

# DISCIPLINE PROCEDURE

1

The 1st time a camper gets in trouble, it is a **WARNING.**

2

The 2nd time a camper gets in trouble, they must be with a sponsor and or **SIT OUT** of an activity.

3

The 3rd time a camper gets in trouble, parents will be called and they will have to go **HOME.**

If at any point a camper is intentionally doing harm to themselves, others, or the campground parents will be contacted and they will be sent home immediately.

(This includes cursing, hitting, kicking, biting, or being completely defiant)

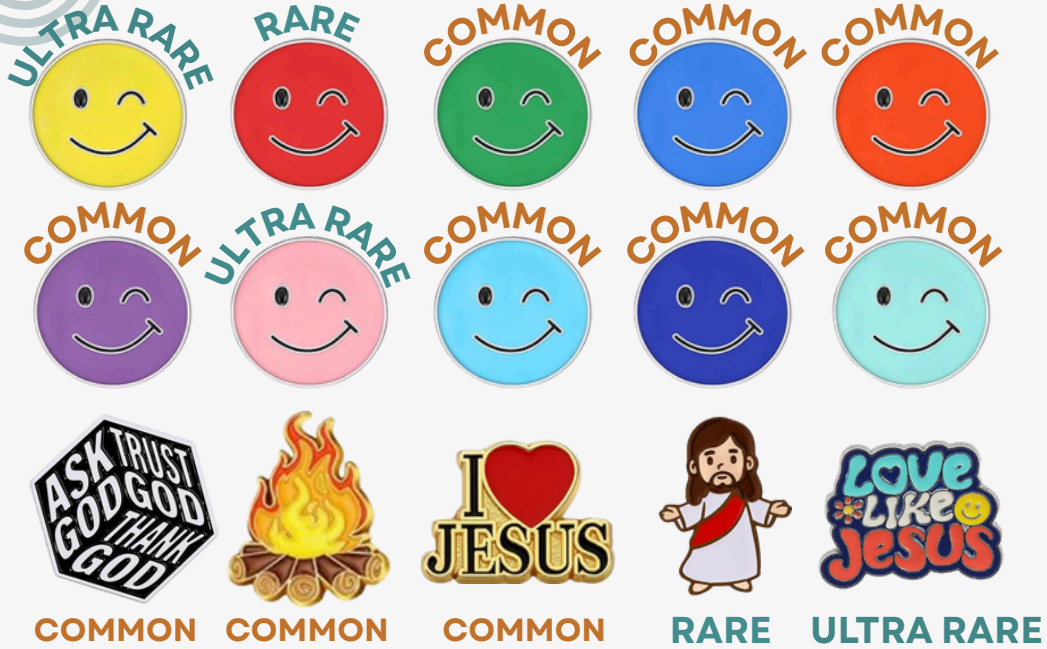

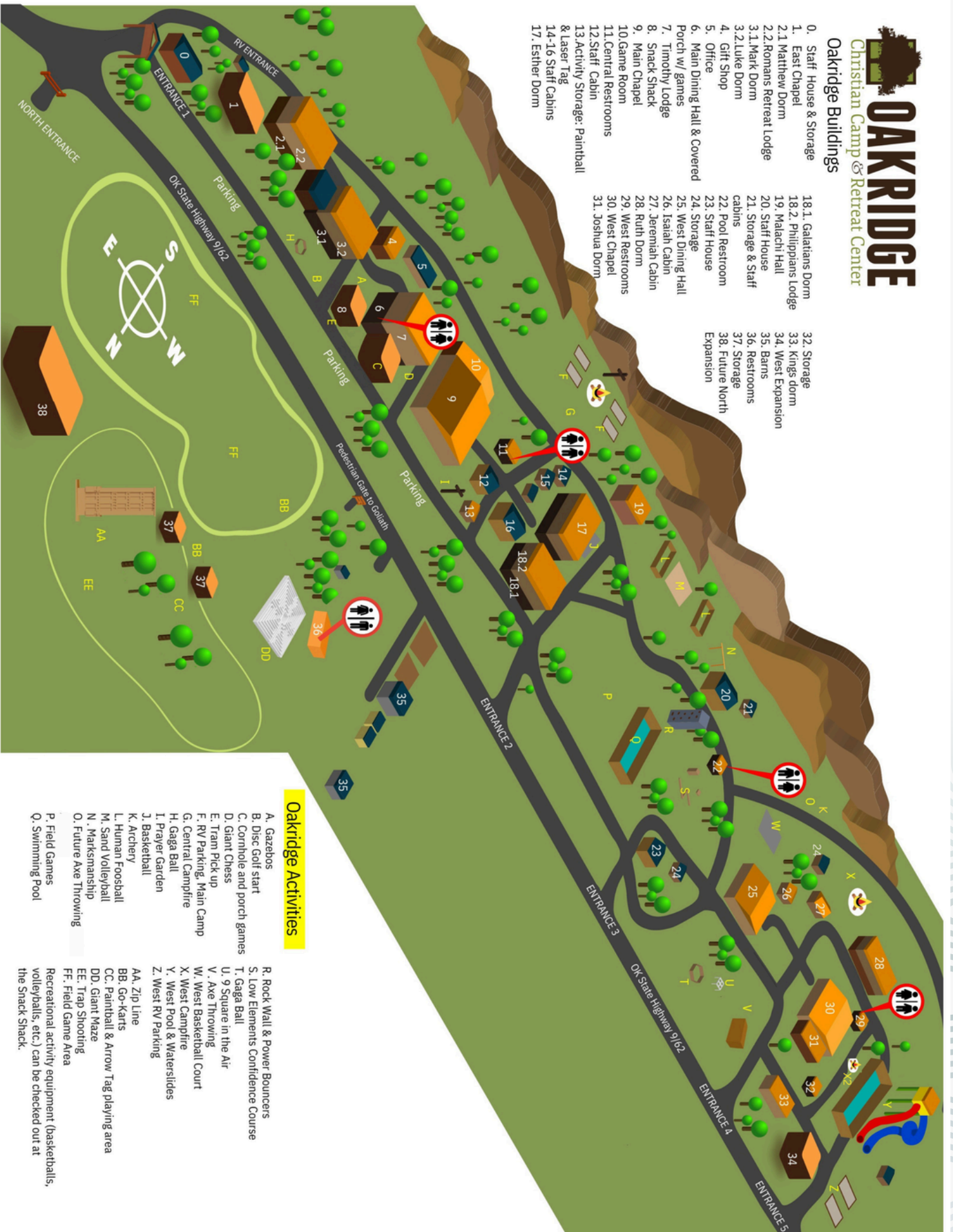
