Children's Camp
Rules and Guidelines

1. Campers are expected to be on best behavior at all times, follow directions from staff, and observe campus rules and guidelines.
2. Campers are not permitted to leave the ground without permission from the Camp Director and/or the Camp Principal.
3. No campers are allowed inside of and/or sitting on vehicles or golf carts unless accompanying an adult.
4. Concerning the conduct of unmarried couples, public displays of affection such as kissing, hugging, holding hands, or any other action not conducive to good, Christian conduct will not be allowed. Couples are to remain in approved areas of the campus designated by the camp staff at all times.
5. All campers must attend and be prompt at all meals and meetings unless excused.
6. Under no circumstances are Boys allowed into the Girls Dormitory, nor are Girls allowed into the Boys Dormitory.
7. All registered campers, if provided, are required to wear their name badges/wrist bands at all times excluding times of recreation.
8. Being that Children's Camp is a place where we come to focus on our relationship with God and with other Apostolic young people, no camper or counselor shall have in their possession at any time: knives, guns, weapons, fireworks, drugs, tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, televisions, and any kind of electronic games or media, etc...
9. Vile, rude, sexual or profane language and behavior is strictly prohibited.
10. All should give respect to the campgrounds, buildings, and facilities. Anyone defacing or destroying property must pay the damage incurred.
11. Campers are permitted only in designated areas.
12. Every camper, counselor, and staff member must be responsible for his or her own bedding, bed, clothing, luggage, and personal belongings.
13. It is required that everyone dress modestly and groom themselves neatly at all times, with no makeup or non-functional jewelry. No clothing with vulgar, distasteful, or suggestive logos, pictures, or slogans is permitted. No clothing that is revealing or form-fitting can be worn on the campground at any time.
14. Athletic equipment and facilities are under the control of the Recreation Director and may be used as specified by her/him.

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15. Girls: Dresses or a skirt and blouse must be worn, with dress or skirt length below the knee; no sleeveless clothing, cap sleeves; no low necklines; no thin or see-through clothing, including T-shirt type material; no dresses or skirts with slits that go above the knee. Shoes must be worn outside of the dormitories.
16. Boys: Regular slacks or jeans must be worn; wind pants and/or sweats will be only permitted during recreation. Shoes must be worn outside of the dormitories.
17. All campers and staff must be fully dressed when moving between dorms and the outside restroom facilities.
18. In the event of an unspecified situation not addressed by these rules, it shall be the responsibility of the Children's Ministry Committee to make a discreet decision concerning the matter.
19. The camp reserves the right to reject or dismiss any applicant [camper or staff member] not complying with the camp rules or who is deemed to have questionable character.
20. Only registered campers will be allowed on campus during daytime camp activities. Evening services are open to everyone.
21. Cell phone and electronics policy: No one under 18 may use their cell phones (calling or texting) during Junior Camp. Adults, age 18 and older, may use their cell phones for calls or texting when they are not with campers. Absolutely no digital pictures of campers may be taken in dorms or bathrooms and no pictures may be posted to any internet site.
22. Photography and Media Notice: The Texico District Children's Ministries will take official pictures for our files and for promotional use. Please understand this policy is to protect the minors in our care.
23. Photography and videos will be taken during camp. I understand that my child may be included in these photos and/or videos. My signature above allows these photos/videos to be used by the Texico District Children's Ministries, its affiliates and representatives, without compensation, with or without my or their name(s) for any lawful purpose, including for example such purposes as publicity, illustration, advertising, and Web content.
24. In the event there are infractions to the rules and guidelines listed above, consequences will be determined by the Campus Principal. In the event that the infraction is major then parents/ guardians and pastor will be contacted promptly and the camper will be referred to the Camp Director and CM Committee for further disciplinary action which may include dismissal of the camper from campgrounds.
