



Greetings Fellow Minister,

At the request of the Texico District Board and a recently convened Budget Committee made up of 5 of our ordained ministers I, respectfully, submit this letter of explanation defining the Financial Plan of the Texico District.

The Overall Texico District Financial Plan:

- It has been established that all licensed ministers pay 75% of what would be considered tithe derived from ministerial income, into the Texico District, with the remaining 25% being given into the local church.

For example, if a minister should make \$1,000.00 in a month in income derived from ministry, his/her tithe would be \$100.00 ($1000.00 \times .10 = 100$).

Of that \$100.00, \$75.00 would be paid to the Texico District Office, while the remaining \$25.00 would be given into the local church offering. ($100 \times .75 = 75$)

Secondary Texico District Financial Plan:

- Understanding that many of our ministers derive their monthly income from secular employment, and very little of their personal income may come from ministry, a secondary plan has been put into place. For these ministers, there is a minimum dues of \$30.00 a month, to be paid to the Texico District Office.
- Please understand, this is only for those licensed ministers who derive little to no monthly income from ministry. (Less than \$400.00 per month)

Discounted Financial Plan For New Ministers:

- There is one more category within our District Financial Plan. A discounted rate is offered to our newer ministers, to help them as they engage in ministry. This discounted rate, for the first five (5) years, is \$20.00 a month.

Please also understand that the Texico District Financial Plan is not the same as the dues we pay into the Headquarters of the United Pentecostal Church International. Every minister is expected to pay both their national level dues, and participate in the agreed upon District Financial Plan.

I pray that you feel as I do; that the Texico District is well worth supporting. We thank God for our annual events like District Conference and Camp Meeting, for our campgrounds, and for the many blessings that flow into our lives from the Texico District Family. Let us all purpose in our hearts to be faithful to support God's work within our own district.
