

Confirm and reaffirm your convictions.


- I. Verify authority and authenticity. V. 1-5
  - a. Matthew is written to present Jesus as the King.

- b. Fulfilled as predicted = Authority. V. 5
    - c. The only time he ever allowed himself to be recognized as king = Daniel's 70<sup>th</sup> week. Daniel 9:24-27, John 6:15


