

Camp Expectations!

First of all, I am so glad that you have chosen to come to Church camp with FBC! Church camp is a moment for students to get away from the hustle and bustle of their everyday life and spend time with like-minded students worshipping and learning King Jesus together. In order for camp to run smoothly rules will be put in place. Mainly for students to know what is expected for their week at camp with FBC Canton.

Know, that you are first representing the King of Kings and Lord of Lords (2 Corinthians 5:20). Second you are representing FBC Canton. We will represent Him well and then we will represent our Church well. I understand that lost students attend camp, but that doesn't give those students an excuse to act like a heathen at camp. If you attend camp with us, you are expected to honor and respect our camp expectations. I didn't say that you had to like them, but you will respect them.

#1. NO PHONES ALLOWED. Students do not bring them to camp at all! If an adult sees a phone, they will take it up and give it back to you when we arrive back at FBC Canton. This is a time when we want to eliminate all distractions. Don't be tempted to bring them.

#2. We will honor Falls Creeks dress code. The dress code is attached to this form for your use in packing. You are without excuse. If there's a clothing item that is questionable, don't pack it. Easy as that!

#3. Students are not allowed in the dorms without adult supervision. We will not hangout in the dorms, take naps, or just sit around. The dorms are for sleeping and getting ready. That's it! I understand that you'll need to run up there and grab something etc., but you must have an adult accompany you. If you find yourself in the dorm by yourself,

go back to the group immediately. If an adult finds you unsupervised, you will get in trouble.

#4. We will be respectful to everyone at camp. I always say, don't be the reason why someone hates camp.

#5. There will be no pranks.

#6. When the lights are out, that means go to sleep. Our leaders are the first ones up and the last ones to go to sleep. Respect their time.

#7. You will participate with our group.

#8. We will follow the schedule given. If you are not where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there, you'll have to be accompanied by an adult. We are not going to play where's Waldo.

#9. Must be in groups of 3 or more.

#10. Jr. High must be accompanied by at least one adult.

#11. Must respect all adults. Disrespect and bad attitudes will not be tolerated.

#12. Cussing will not be tolerated.

#13. We will display good sportsmanship. Falls Creek can be competitive if you participate in different activities. We will not be bad sports.

#14. This is common sense but no vaping, tobacco products, alcohol or drugs.

#15. All medication must be turned into our camp nurse.

#16. No PDA (Public display of affection). This is Church camp, not date night.

#17. Avoid the talk of weapons. If Falls Creek staff hears it, you will be going home immediately. Falls Creek security is extremely serious.

If your student respects our camp expectations, camp will be great for themselves as well as everyone else. If they do not, (depending on the seriousness of the offense) the parent will be called to come and pick up their student from camp. Sending a student home is never FBC's intention, but there will be some things that we will not tolerate.
