Year 2, explores Dating in a retreat setting designed to engage, inform, and impact High School students in Godly dating principals; principals that teach dating and breaking up from a Christian world view.

Year 3 is a discussion on Sex, specifically, the power and purpose of this gift from God. Except for Adam, Eve and Jesus, every person alive came to be because of a sexual connection. We are sexual beings, but what does that mean? What is God's intention for sex and sexual understanding?

Year 4 (THIS YEARS THEME) is an exhaustive study of the book of Song of Solomon. We study the book from the traditional Jewish perspective; it's a story of love and lust, a true-to-life story of love under attack. There's so much to learn from this amazing book!
