Discussion Questions

Elementary

1. Joseph had to wait a very long time before God's plan became clear. What can we learn about trusting God when we have to wait?
2. Joseph forgave his brothers even after they hurt him very badly. Why is forgiveness hard, and how can God help us do it?
3. Joseph knew God was still working even through something painful. How does that help us trust God when hard things happen?

Middle School

1. Joseph waited 22 years before revealing himself to his brothers. What does his story teach us about trusting God when life feels confusing or unfair?
2. Joseph forgave the brothers who sold him into slavery. What does that show us about how God can change a person's heart?
3. Joseph saw that God was working even through suffering and sin. How does that help you think differently about your own struggles?

High School

1. Joseph's long season of suffering shows that God's purposes often unfold slowly. How does patience in hardship shape our ability to trust God's bigger plan?
2. Joseph was able to forgive the very brothers who betrayed him. What does that reveal about the kind of transformation God produces in a heart that understands His sovereignty?
3. Joseph recognized that human sin could not cancel God's promises. How does that truth challenge the way you view betrayal, suffering, or disappointment in your own life?
