*Discussion Questions*

## **Elementary**

1. Joseph went through many hard things, but God was still working. What is one hard thing where you need to remember that God is with you?
2. Joseph forgave his brothers even though they had hurt him. Why is it hard to forgive someone who has been mean or unfair to you?
3. Joseph trusted God's promises even though he did not see everything happen before he died. What is one promise from God that helps you trust Him?

## **Middle School**

1. Joseph said, "You meant evil against me, but God meant it for good." How can that help you when someone hurts you or treats you unfairly?
2. Joseph had the power to get revenge, but he chose to comfort and care for his brothers. Where is God calling you to respond with grace instead of getting even?
3. God used Joseph's trials to build humility, faithfulness, endurance, wisdom, and forgiveness. Which of those do you think God may be growing in you right now?

## **High School**

1. Joseph's story shows that God can be working even when life feels delayed, unfair, or confusing. What situation in your life is hard to understand right now, and how might God be asking you to trust Him in it?
2. Joseph remembered that he was not "in the place of God." How would remembering that God is the Judge change the way you respond to people who have wronged you?
3. Joseph died still trusting that God would keep His promises to His people. How does the cross help you trust God when you cannot see the bigger picture yet?
