

QUESTIONS ABOUT OUR SUMMER 2026 PROGRAM? Maybe the following will help!

****WHO CAN ATTEND THE SUMMER PROGRAM?** This program is open to children who are 18 months of age by June 1 through those who have completed kindergarten.

****WHAT IS THE REGISTRATION FEE?** MDS requires a one-time non-refundable summer program registration fee of \$100 for all current students and students registered for the 2026-2027 school year. There is a \$200 non-refundable registration fee for non-MDS students. Summer program students that pay the \$200 registration fee and are not already registered for the 2026-2027 school year, will be eligible to receive a \$100 discount on the registration fee when you choose to register for the 2026-2027 school year.

****WHAT DO I HAVE TO BRING TO REGISTER?** Bring your completed summer registration form (available online at www.fumcvictoria.com) and the registration fee to Methodist Day School to reserve your spot for the summer. Staff members are on campus each school day from 7:30am to 4:00pm to accept registration form and payment. Space is limited. Sign up today!

****WHAT FORMS OF PAYMENT ARE ACCEPTED?** We accept cash (no change given- over payment applied to future invoices), check (made payable to MDS), or money order. We do not accept cards.

****WHAT DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED AFTER I REGISTER?** All registered students must complete emergency medical cards, admission form, identification card form, submit shot records, and a well-child statement. Children ages 4 and older must also have passing vision and hearing exams on file. Returning 2025–2026 students only need to complete new emergency medical cards. All documents are due with the first month's payment on or before May 15, 2026.

****WHAT DATES AND TIMES ARE OFFERED?** We are offering Monday-Friday care for the months of June and July. We will be closed July 3 in observance of Independence Day. Half-day (7:30am-12:30pm) and full-day (7:30am-5:30pm) program options are available. All students must be in attendance by 8:50am to attend for the day.

****WHAT IS OFFERED?** Activities will include theme weeks with arts and crafts, circle time, and outside play. MDS will provide morning and afternoon snacks, and a parent provided lunch will be served daily at 11:30am. Those students staying after 12:30pm will nap.

****WHAT DOES MY CHILD NEED DAILY?** A backpack, a change of clothes in a zip top bag, a water bottle cleaned and filled daily, and a lunch. For those staying after 12:30, students need to bring a red/blue sleep mat (we have mats available for purchase in the MDS office) and a small blanket and pillow. For those not potty trained, please send diapers\pull ups and wipes.

****HOW DO I PICK UP AND DROP OFF MY STUDENT?** All students will be dropped off at the playground to be signed in by a staff member. Pick up for half-day students will be from 12:15-12:30pm from the playground. Pick up for full-day students will be at the front door. Photo identification or MDS identification card is required. A late fee of \$10 will be charged per 15 minutes late after 12:30pm for half-day students and after 5:30pm for full-day students.

****DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO BE POTTY TRAINED TO ATTEND?** If your child was 3 years of age before September 1, 2025, he/she must be completely potty trained for the summer 2026 program.
