- 1. Applications for scholarships consist of three (3) parts:
 - a) Scholarship Application (3 pages)
 - b) Copy of parents' most recent Federal Income Tax 1040 Form: This must be complete including all schedules.
 - c) Letter of recommendation from another school, child care facility, or non-relative.
- 2. All information contained in the application <u>will be confidential</u>. A scholarship committee made up of Methodist Day School staff, parents, and First United Methodist Church members will review all scholarship applications. Please answer all questions fully. Blank spaces on the application or failure to provide a current tax form and/or insufficient information will be cause to reject the application. Additional information that will be helpful to Methodist Day School is welcome.
- 3. One scholarship application per family.
