DAY 2: EVERYONE HAS VALUE

Read Romans 15:17

It's easy to decide who matters. People who are popular, fun, or a lot like you can be easier to notice. But Jesus did something different, He saw people others ignored. He chose to talk to someone others avoided. He showed that every person has value. That means the people around you matter. The quiet kid. The one who feels left out. The one who seems different. You don't have to change someone's whole life. Just start by seeing them.

DAY 3: CHOOSE TO SEE OTHERS

Read 1 Samuel 16:7

People often look at the outside. They notice clothes, popularity, or skills. But God looks at the heart. And Jesus teaches us to do the same. It takes effort to get to know someone beyond what you can see. It means asking questions and being interested in them. It means showing compassion and kindness. It means treating them like they're valuable and worth your time. It means encouraging them with something good you see in them or something they've said or done. You may never know how much that kindness can impact someone's day.

DAY 4: SMALL ACTIONS MATTER

Read Galatians 6:9

Sometimes it feels like small actions don't matter. A kind word. A simple invite. A quick moment of help. But those small things can make a big difference. Jesus showed that even one conversation can change everything. You don't have to do something huge. Just start. God can take your small action and use it in ways you can't see. Don't wait for the perfect moment. Start with what you see.
