DAY 2: GOD GAVE YOU GIFTS

Read James 1:17

God has given you gifts. These aren't random talents or skills. They're from Him, and they have a purpose. You might be good at encouraging people. You might be creative or organized. You might notice when someone needs help. Those things matter more than you think. God gave you those gifts so you can be part of what He's doing. You don't have to be the best or have everything figured out. Just bring what you have, and say yes.

DAY 3: YOU AREN'T MEANT TO DO IT ALONE

Read Ecclesiastes 4:9

DAY 4: DON'T HIT PAUSE

Read 2 Timothy 1:6

Have you ever paused a game right when things were getting exciting? Everything just stops. Nothing moves. Sometimes we do that with our gifts. God has already placed something inside you. A way to help. A way to lead. A way to encourage others. But if you don't use it, it's like hitting pause. Nothing happens. Second Timothy 1:6 (NIV) says to "fan into flame" your gift. That means don't leave it sitting there. Use it. Try it. Practice it. Step out. You don't have to be perfect. You just have to start. God is the One who grows your gift. He does the impossible part. You just press play!

Read 1 Corinthians 3:7
