ABRAHAM'S BIG TEST

1ST HAPPY TO WAIT

directions on back

YOU'LL NEED

- Toy clock (1 per room)

2ND SAY WITH ME

all ages

Say Together: I show faith every day, when I trust and obey.

3RD QUESTIONS

age 4

- **Why do you wait with a good attitude?** *To show faith in God*
- **Who can help you when you have to wait, and wait, and wait ... for a really long time?** *God, Jesus, our parents, our teachers, our leaders, etc.*

HAPPY TO WAIT

directions

1. **Show** clock.

Ask: What's this? What do you use it for?

2. Kids **respond**.

Say: That's right! It shows the time, and it helps you wait. Let's practice waiting to play a froggy jumping game! Do you wanna play it with me?

3. Kids **respond**.

Say: Okay! First, you have to crouch down and stay still and quiet—like a stone. Don't move a muscle!

4. **Move** clock hands to 3:00.

Whisper: When these clock hands point all the way up, you get to jump like frogs! We're waiting ... waiting ... waiting.

5. **Slowly move** the hour hand while you talk from 3:00 to 12:00

Say: We waited! Jump, frogs, jump!

6. Kids **stand** and **jump** for a few seconds,

7. Get kids to **crouch down** again and **be still**.

8. **Repeat** steps 4-7 again as time allows, but **move** clock hands more slowly each time.

Say: Friends, you waited with a good attitude! When you wait with a good attitude, you show faith in God. He'll give you what you need when it's the right time!

9. **Say** "Say With Me" listed on the front.

10. For age 4, **ask** "Questions" listed on the front.
