PRE SERVICE ACTIVITY

Water bottle Tic-Tac-Toe

What You Need

-  Painter's tape 1
-  Plastic water bottles (partially filled with water) 1

What You Do:

Before the Activity:

- Create a large Tic-Tac-Toe grid in the middle of the table with tape.
- Stack nine cups of each color, and place one stack on either side of the Tic-Tac-Toe grid.
- Set one bottle on either side.

During the Activity:

- Welcome kids by name with a high-five, fist bump, smile, or wave as they arrive.
- Invite any kids who brought an offering to place it in the offering container.
- Explain the game: "We're playing Tic-Tac-Toe, but to place your mark (*hold up a cup*), you have to successfully flip a water bottle and have it land upright."
- Say: "Both teams will be flipping their bottles at the same time. Once you have successfully flipped and landed your team's bottle, you may place a cup in a square, then the next player from your team may play."
- Continue playing until one team gets three in a row—straight down, across, or diagonal.

What You Say:

"That took some serious skill! It's fun to try and land the perfect flip. In our Bible Story today, Jesus met a woman at a well, and the conversation they had changed her life forever. It's a story that shows us something powerful about who Jesus values. Let's go find out more!"

What You Say:

OPENER

HOST: "Hey, everyone! I'm so glad you're here! If it's your first time with us, welcome! Jump in with us today. We're continuing our theme for the month called 'Masterpiece!'"

"The full name of our series this month is 'Masterpiece—Made by God,' and we've been talking about how we are God's masterpiece—His most special creation! We're going to learn more about that a little later, and it's going to be a great day!"

"But first, I want to see how many creatives are in the room. I'm going to say a few things, and if one of them has happened to you, stand up. If not, stay seated."

"Stand up if you've ever built something and immediately wanted to show someone."

(Pause while kids stand up.)

"Stand up if you've ever made something that looked way better in your head."

(Pause while kids stand up.)

"Stand up if you've ever said, 'It's fine ... it's abstract.'"

(Pause while kids stand up.)

"Stand up if you've ever gotten Play-Doh® colors mixed together and just accepted your fate."

(Pause while kids stand up.)

"Stand up if you're ready for a 30-second challenge."

(Pause while kids stand up.)

"Love it!"

"It's officially game time. Today's game is called ... 'Make It Fast!'"

GAME SLIDE 1: Make It Fast Title

"I need four volunteers for Round One. If you like fast challenges, raise your hand!"

(Pick four kids from the ones who have their hands raised, invite them to the game area, and have them stand behind the table. Give each kid a paper plate and a container of Play-Doh®.)

"Here's the deal: I'm going to give you an object to make. You get 30 seconds to sculpt it. When time's up, freeze and hold your plate up to show everyone. No last-second edits."

"Everyone watching, your job is to be the crowd. These artists need big encouragement!"

"Artists, are you ready to sculpt? Your job is to make a mountain. I want to see snow-covered peaks and some evergreens spread throughout. Maybe even a valley down below. And remember ... you only have 30 seconds to do it. Happy sculpting!"

"On your mark, get set, GO!"

Optional Video: 30-Second Countdown

(Start 30-second timer. Allow the kids to sculpt until the 30-second timer is up.)

"That's time! No more sculpting! Let's see these beautiful mountains!"

"Nice! These are just really cute little mountains, I have to say. Let's give a big round of applause for all our sculptors!"

(Pick a winner out of the four sculptures, and declare the winner.)

"And ... we have a winner! Great job, sculptors, and great cheering from the rest of you!"

(Continue with more rounds as time allows. Select four new volunteers, and give new volunteers new paper plates and new Play-Doh® at the start of each round.)

(Ideas for other objects the kids can make: globe, arrow, frame, hand, self-portrait. To get even more creative, you

can give the kids challenges: sculpting with one hand, keeping the sculpture flat on the plate, making the sculpture as tiny as possible but still recognizable.)

"What a blast! You all made some fast pieces of very unique art. We love to see it.

"It looks like it's time to check out our Bottom Line for today! This is a great one, as always!

SLIDE: Bottom Line

[Bottom Line] "Jesus values everyone. Can you say that with me?"

KIDS AND HOST: **[Bottom Line]** "Jesus values everyone."

HOST: "Great job! Now get ready, because we're going to be learning more about that very soon!"

"Each month, we take time to focus on one verse from the Bible. Why? Because God's Word is full of truth. It reminds us who God is, and it also reminds us who we are. This verse isn't just words we try to memorize—it's something we can believe and live out.

"This month, our Memory Verse comes from the book of Psalms. I'll read it first, then I will lead you through it!

LEADER: "This verse isn't just for today—it's for every day! You can write it down and memorize it. And the more you remember it, the more it becomes part of how you see yourself. You were made by God. On purpose. Wonderfully!"

"Thanks for worshiping with me today, friends!"

What You Say:

Leader: "Let's talk to God together, friends. You can bow your heads and close your eyes."

Kids, have you ever made a mistake? Maybe you disobeyed your parents, were unkind to a friend, or told a lie.

The Bible calls those things sin. Every one of us has sinned—even grown-ups! Sin separates us from God, and no matter how hard we try, we can't fix that problem on our own.

That's why we need Jesus. Jesus loves us so much that He came to take the punishment for our sins so we could be close to God and have eternal life with Him.

SMALL GROUP ACTIVITY ONE

Spread the News

What You Need

 Large, plastic jar

Maybe you've heard about Jesus before, but you've never personally asked Him to be your forever friend. Today, you can make that choice.

If you have never asked Jesus to be your forever friend, and today you want to say 'yes' to Jesus, raise your hand right now."

(Pause and look for raised hands.)

"That's amazing! Let's all pray together. Repeat after me:
READ THE ABC PRAYER

(Tech Crew) Slides A, B, C

Leaders read each slide and have kids repeat after you.

SLIDE: Theme

What You Do:

During the Activity:

- Ask for three volunteers, and select one kid to be the person at the well. Have them stand on one side of the room holding the jar.
- Have the two other kids stand on the opposite side of the room.
- Explain the game: "In our Bible Story, the woman at the well was so excited about Jesus that she ran to tell everyone in her town. She was so excited that He valued her so much by talking to her! When I say, 'Go,' you two are going to race to be the first one to get to the person at the well and share the good news that Jesus loves them so much, He came to rescue them!"
- On "Go," the two kids race to the other side. The first one to tap the kid holding the jar on the shoulder and say: "Jesus loves everyone so much that He came to rescue them" wins the round.

- Let the winner become the new person at the well, and choose two new racers.
- Continue until everyone has had a chance to race and share the good news.

What You Say:

"Great job racing and spreading that amazing news! That's exactly what the woman in our Bible Story did. She didn't keep the good news about Jesus to herself—she shared it! We can do that too. We can tell our friends and family the most wonderful truth: **[Bottom Line] Jesus values everyone!** He loves everyone so much that He gave His life to rescue them!

"Remember that no matter who you are, where you live, or what you've done, you are made in the image of God. God has a purpose for you and loves you so much that He sent Jesus to rescue you. The same thing is true of every single person you will ever meet—your family, friends, people at school and in your neighborhood, and so on. Our job is to love and value others like Jesus does. No one is beyond God's reach, and He wants them all to come to know Him.

"So be a noticer of people. Every single person you come across, every single one, is loved by God. Jesus gave His life to rescue them. Say 'hi' to someone you usually don't talk to. Use their name. Ask one normal question. Invite them to sit with you. Stand next to someone who is alone. Those small choices communicate something big, which is, 'You matter.' And they do. They matter so much to Jesus!"

SMALL GROUP| ACTIVITY TWO

Masterpiece Pose

What You Need

 Bible

What You Do:

During the Activity:

- Give every kid a Bible, and direct them to look up Psalm 139:14.
- Demonstrate how to look up the Memory Verse using the Bible Navigation Tips below:

Finding verses for nd2-3rd graders: Guide them to open their Bibles to the front and find the table of contents. (Hold up a Bible opened to the table of contents to show the kids what the page looks like.) When the kids find the table of contents, lead them to find the name of the book in the list. When they find the book, lead them to look at the page number beside it. Explain that the number tells them on what page they can find that book. Help the kids find the page. When they find the book, explain that the big numbers on the page are the chapter numbers. Help them find the correct chapter. Then explain that the small numbers are verse numbers. Help them find the correct verse in that chapter.

- Repeat the Memory Verse out loud together several times.
- Review any words that might be unfamiliar to the kids.
- Invite the kids to set their Bibles aside.
- Invite the kids to stand up and spread out.
- Explain the game: "You will say the Memory Verse together, and every time you say the word 'YOU,' everyone must freeze and strike a pose like a priceless statue in a museum—a masterpiece!"
- Practice a few masterpiece poses together. They can be silly, serious, or strong!
- Lead the group in saying the verse and freezing on each "YOU."
- *How **you** made me is amazing and wonderful. I praise **you** for that. What **you** have done is wonderful. I know that very well (Psalm 139:14 NlrV).*
- Play several times, challenging the kids to strike a different masterpiece pose each time.

What You Say:

"Awesome job with those masterpiece poses! This game is a perfect way to remember our Memory Verse. Every time we froze, we were reminding ourselves of this amazing truth: God made YOU! The verse says: *How you made me is amazing and wonderful (Psalm 139:14 NlrV)*. This verse is not talking about your friend or your brother; it's talking about YOU! God made you, and He thinks you are amazing and wonderful. You don't have to do anything to earn it. You just are.

What You Do:

During the Activity:

- Give each kid a piece of paper and a marker.
- Show them how to trace their hand on the paper. Offer to help if they need it.
- Explain that you are going to make a "Five-Finger Prayer" to remember that Jesus values all kinds of people.
- On each finger of their traced hand, help them write a category of people to pray for:
- Pinky Finger: Someone younger than me
- Ring Finger: A community helper (teacher, firefighter, doctor)
- Middle Finger: A family member
- Pointer Finger: A friend
- Thumb: Someone I don't know very well
- Once their hand is labeled, go through each finger, and pray together for those people.

What You Say:

"This is a great way to remember to pray for all kinds of people because **[Bottom Line] Jesus values everyone!** Let's hold our prayer hands and talk to God right now."
