IMPORTANT NOTES FOR ALL LEADERS

Preschool:

- Saturday & Sunday: Split into 2–3 yrs and 4–5 yrs classrooms due to high attendance expectations. Story time will happen in your rooms, we will not combine. Egg hunt activity will happen in your rooms as well.

Preschool Egg Hunt Instructions

The preschool egg hunt will be fun, simple, and organized for all kids to enjoy. Group kids into teams and assign a specific egg color, their goal is to collect only the eggs that match their assigned color. For example, you may have 3 kids assigned to pink eggs, 3 to blue eggs, 3 to green eggs, and so on, depending on the class size.

The check-in team will provide each classroom with a bin of eggs, and leaders will spread them out throughout the classroom. During the hunt, clearly remind the kids to only pick up their color eggs. As they collect them, they will bring the eggs over to a basket. The hunt continues until all eggs have been collected.

Please note that there will be no candy inside the eggs—candy bags will be handed out at check-out. Keep instructions simple, help kids with colors if needed, and most importantly, make it a fun and joyful experience for everyone! 🎉

Elementary (K–5th):

- Leaders report to **The Hub (Youth Room)**
- You will be assigned a number square to lead.
- Kids will be assigned to your square evenly. We will be giving them a color dot sticker that will match your square.

Service Flow:

- Sit with your group
- Lead a **pre-service craft/activity**
- Kids will:
 - Watch opener & worship
 - Experience the Easter story (youth production)
- **Salvation Moment:** Led by James R.
 - During salvation the leader will hand out **salvation cards to all kids in your square that raises their hand.**
 - Mark responses on check-in list

Elementary Egg Hunt Instructions

- Groups will be called **one at a time** to the egg hunt room.
- Waiting groups will do **Activity 1 & 2**
- Candy distributed at **check-out**

♥ FINAL REMINDER

Leaders, you do **NOT** need to check kids in. James and Myself will be signing kids into the Hub and assigning them to your square.

Your focus is to **connect, engage, and enjoy the experience with the kids.**
