Souled Out Summer Camp - June 1-5, 2026 Laguna Beach Resort

Souled Out is a Christian conference for middle and high school students. It is held at Laguna Beach Christian Retreat on the west end of Panama City Beach, Florida and it focuses on students' relationships with Christ. Morning and evening worship and speakers set the tone for each day. The conference is discipleship oriented, and each student will participate in a D-Group (disciple group) made up of students of their grade and gender. Each D-group is led by college age Discipleship Leaders (D-Leaders) whose focus is on helping students open up and grow closer to Christ. Lots of free time is scheduled each afternoon for individual activities, swimming at the pools or beach, playing basketball, ultimate frisbee, volleyball, tournaments, competing in the strong man/woman contest, or just hanging out and relaxing. Souled Out is the perfect setting for students to open up and be real before God and with each other.

Bible Studies will be led by Lee Mc Bride & Jordan Easley. Worship will be led by Jonathan and Lisa Moore Band. Dear Church Family,

I am writing to share an update on the Good News Club (GNC) Ministry. We have just completed six weeks in two local elementary schools, teaching the Good News to approximately 115 children. As we conclude this spring session of the GNC, we look back at the wonderful opportunity we had to plant seeds, water and nurture others, and see some bloom into professions of faith. While it was a trying time in one club due to the children being more active and disruptive, we witnessed firsthand that God is more powerful and always in

control. He gave leaders the stamina to manage the challenges, and as the Bible stories began, the children were settled and listening. As a result, God drew three children from this specific club to Himself, and we are celebrating those three professions of faith. We thank God for the time we spent loving these children, and we ask that you join us in prayer:

Here is an update on the **Property Improvement** account to pay for the Cameras, Front Doors and Playground (swings, mulch and equipment).

Total need for Cameras and Doors \$ 56,503.11

The Playground total was \$138,751. This total will be revised after looking at the possibility of taking one playground down and having a picnic pavilion instead.




