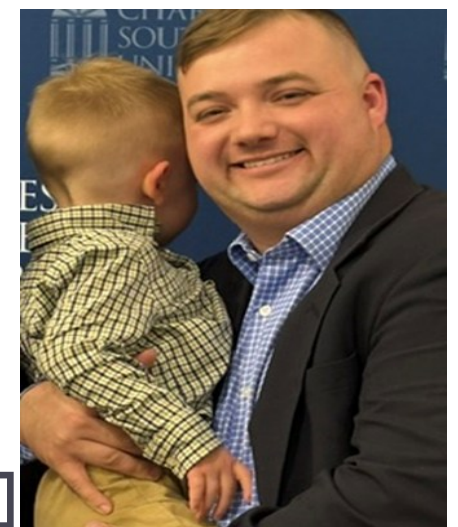
Qualifications for Deacons
