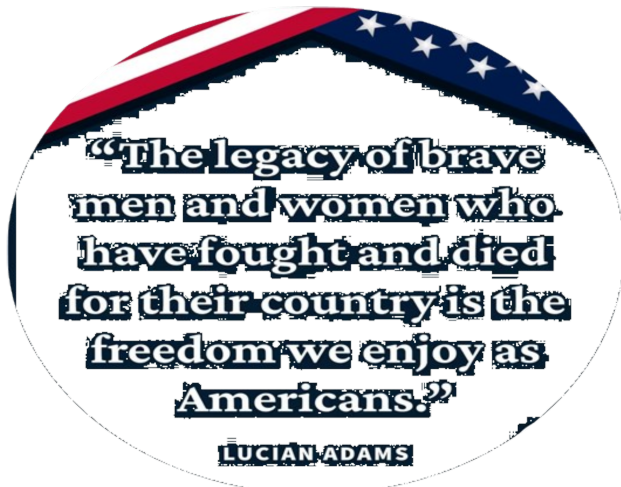

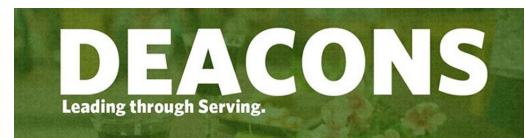

Qualifications of a Deacon according to 1 Timothy 3:8 -13

8Deacons likewise must be dignified, not double-tongued,^s not addicted to much wine, not greedy for dishonest gain. **9**They must hold the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience. **10**And let them also be tested first; then let them serve as deacons if they prove themselves blameless. **11**Their wives likewise^d must be dignified, not slanderers, but sober-minded, faithful in all things. **12**Let deacons each be the husband of one wife, managing their children and their own households well. **13**For those who serve well as deacons gain a good standing for themselves and also great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.
