Intercessory Prayer Ministry

How to pray for the world in 5 minutes.

Praying for World Evangelism centers basically around four areas. The four areas we claim for world-changing prayer.

First, Claim Workers for the Harvest. Matthew 9:38 NASB "Therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into his harvest."

Second, Claim Open Doors. "Devote yourselves to prayer...that God may open up a door for his word." Col. 4:2-3 NASB

Third, Claim "fruit" that will remain. "Pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified." 2Thess. 3:1NASB

Fourth, Claim a strong base of support for the Missionary Outreach. "How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe on him whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach except they be sent?" Romans 10:14-15.

The above is written by Dick Eastman in "The Hour That changes the World". We have a map of the World from Dick Eastman's ministry, "Every Home For Christ" to go to every Adult Sunday School Class. The map includes a place where we can sketch your neighborhood so you can pray daily for your neighbors. We would like you to sketch the Red Bank area around the church. Maps are free and you can order some for yourself where you can sketch your own personal neighborhood on it if you want one.

If you would like the prayer book "The Hour That Changes The World" by Dick Eastman (A practical guide for Personal Prayer), you can order them through AMAZON for (\$10 plus S&T). This is the book behind the Prayer Clock that we have in the prayer room for those who are not sure they can pray for an hour.

We are shifting how we pray in Sunday School beginning in September. Each class will be praying for missions only. Ministries are going to prayer groups.

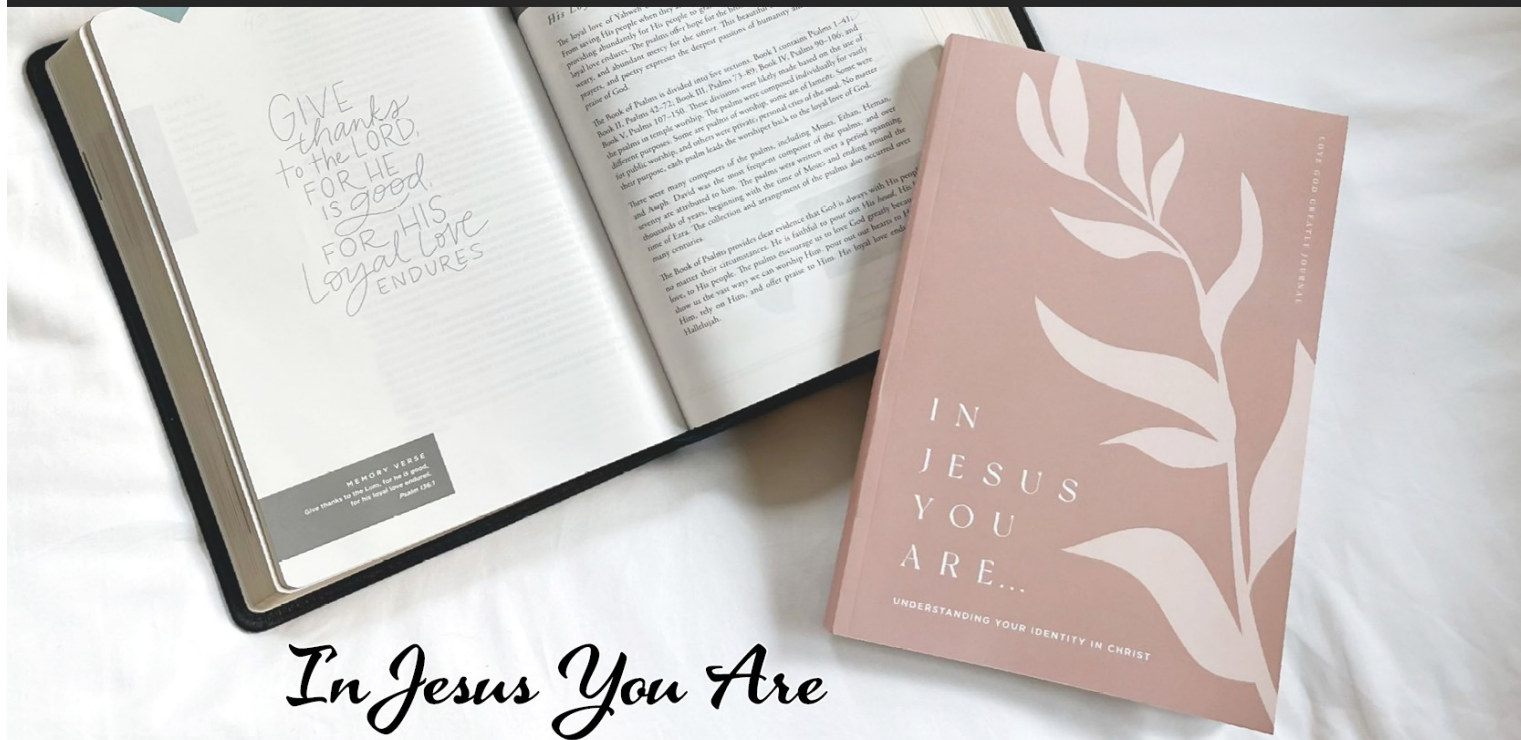
