



Romans 5:6-11

The Results of Justification (Part 2)

- I. **Introduction:** Paul explains that God has given Christians many privileges as a result of their justification in Christ and encourages them to worship God.

- II. The Results of Justification (**Rom 5:6-11**).
 - A. Loved by God (**vv. 6-8**).
 1. Paul proclaimed that God's love has been demonstrated at the cross: while sinners hated Him, He sacrificed His only Son so that they could have eternal life.

 - B. Rescued from God (**v. 9**).
 1. Paul declared that we have been delivered from God's wrath forever through the blood of Jesus, ensuring that our salvation is secure.

 - C. Reconciled to God (**vv. 10-11**).
 1. Paul proclaimed that we have been reconciled to God through Jesus' sacrificial death, and that our hope is worth exalting God about.

- III. **Conclusion:** Paul explains that God has justified sinners by His supernatural power and that many blessings flow from our new position in Jesus.



Questions About: The Result of Justification

1. How does Paul focus on the benefits of justification? **(Rom 5:1-11)** What four benefits did Paul say a justified person experiences? **(Rom 5:1-5)** Are these a comfort to you?
2. What is the next privilege that Paul says a Christian experiences? **(Rom 5:6-8)** How has God's love been poured out on us? **(Rom 5:5)** What state were we in when we were saved? **(v. 6)**
3. What does Paul pray that we may come to understand about love? **(Eph 3:14-19)** How is God's love different than ours? **(Rom 5:7-8)** When did Jesus die for our sins? **(Rom 5:8)**
4. What is the next privilege that Paul says is even better than the last? **(Rom 5:9)** How have we been justified before God? **(v. 9)** From what is a Christian saved? **(v. 6)**
5. How has Paul already talked about God's wrath? **(Rom 1:18)** Who spoke the most about God's wrath and hell in the Bible? **(Matt 3:7)** Why do people not want to talk about God's wrath?
6. What is the last privilege that Paul speaks about in this passage? **(Rom 5:10-11)** What is reconciliation? **(v. 10)** How were we enemies of God before our justification? **(v. 10)**
7. How are we reconciled to God now? **(2 Cor 5:18-20)** How do we know that God will welcome us into heaven? **(Luke 15:11-32)** How is our salvation secure in Christ? **(v. 11)**
8. Why do we praise God for all these blessings? **(Rom 5:2, 3, 11)** Why is Christianity a religion that sings? **(Psa 34:3, 21; 43:3)** Are you thankful for God's love? Will you praise Him?

Prayer

1. Pray that God would help you better appreciate all the blessings you have in Jesus.
2. Ask God to help you praise Him for the blessings He has given us through His Son.
