Summer can also be a wonderful opportunity to grow spiritually through good Christian reading. One of the great blessings God has given His church is the faithful men and women throughout history who have written books that help us better understand Scripture, deepen our love for Christ, and strengthen our walk with Him. I often encourage believers to develop the habit of reading solid Christian books alongside their daily Bible reading. While no book ever replaces Scripture, good books can help sharpen our thinking, warm our hearts, and point us back to the truth of God's Word. With that in mind, I wanted to share a few books that I would gladly recommend for summer reading this year.


For those interested in theology and Christian living, I would highly recommend John MacArthur's *The Gospel According to Jesus*. This book is a helpful and biblical reminder of what true saving faith looks like and calls believers to consider the lordship of Christ carefully. R. C. Sproul's *The Holiness of God* remains one of the most impactful books I have ever read on the character of God. Sproul helps readers see the greatness, majesty, and purity of the Lord in a way that produces both awe and worship. John Piper's *Desiring God* is another excellent book that challenges believers to find their deepest joy and satisfaction in God Himself.

If you are looking for something more devotional in nature, A. W. Tozer's *The Knowledge of the Holy* is a timeless classic that reflects deeply on the attributes and character of God. Arthur Pink's *The Attributes of God* is another rich and thoughtful work that helps believers meditate on who God is.

I would also recommend T. Desmond Alexander's *The City of God*, which traces the storyline of Scripture from Genesis to Revelation and beautifully highlights God's unfolding plan of redemption.

I would also encourage you not to overlook Christian biographies. Few things stir the heart like reading about the faithfulness of believers who have gone before us. Rob MacKenzie's *David Livingstone: The Truth Behind the Legend* provides a fascinating look at the life and missionary labors of one of the most well-known missionaries in church history. Eric Metaxas' *Martin Luther: The Man Who Rediscovered God and Changed the World* offers an engaging introduction to the life of the great Reformer and the recovery of the gospel during the Protestant Reformation. Arnold Dallimore's biography of George Whitefield is another outstanding work that recounts the remarkable ministry of one of the greatest evangelists God has ever used.

My prayer is that this summer would not only be a season of physical refreshment but also a season of spiritual growth for our church family. May we continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ as we fill our minds with truth that honors Him.
