The past five-week sprint, from early January to now, has been tiring, but God's work among the students makes us grateful! Our outreach efforts have led to 40 new student surveys from Sac State and valuable connections at American River College and Sac City College.

The first week of classes featured two events: a drop-in "Meet & Greet" on Thursday in the Sac State Union for students to connect between classes, with swag and school materials offered, and a bowling event at the end of the week to welcome new and returning friends.

At the Meet & Greet, I (Leo) connected with Ismael, a student from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DR Congo) whom we had met the day before. He was introduced by his friend, Mo. We bonded quickly over our shared love for soccer and talked about African culture. I sensed an opportunity to discuss spiritual matters. Ismael shared that DR Congo is a strong Catholic nation. However, I was struck when he shared that he and his parents are Muslim. Ismael explained, "My Father would often travel to the country Chad for work. One time, a colleague of his there gave him a quran. When he returned, he started reading it. After a while he converted to Islam, along with us." While his extended family remains Catholic, Ismael and his immediate family are Muslim.

This interaction is a profound opportunity! Imagine the Lord changing Ismael's heart through the connections in our ministry—what if he is given a Bible and the darkness that entered his family is severed? Please pray that Ismael is receptive to our ministry team reaching out so the Lord can draw him to Himself!

PASTOR STUART FRASER

Dear FBC Family,

As we move toward Easter, our hearts are drawn again to the cross and the empty tomb. We remember that Christ died for our sins and was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures (1 Cor 15:3-4). But Easter is more than a moment in history. It is the announcement that God has decisively acted to justify sinners. The question that has echoed through human history is this: How can a sinful person stand right before a holy God? Job once asked, "How can a man be in the right before God?" (Job 9:2). Thankfully, Scripture answers that question with clarity and hope. The book of Romans reveals to us that God justifies sinners by faith in Jesus Christ. And the resurrection of Christ confirms that the work of salvation is complete and that those who trust in Him are truly accepted (Rom 4:25).

In Romans 3:23, Paul explains that "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." The Bible makes clear that none of us can achieve the righteousness of God on our own. Paul says that "By the works of the Law no flesh will be justified in His sight" (Rom 3:20). No amount of moral effort or religious devotion can remove our guilt. Yet God, in His grace, has provided a righteousness apart from our spiritual performance. Paul writes that we are "justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus" (Rom 3:24). And that God has presented Christ publicly as a propitiation in His blood (Rom 3:25). God did this so that at the cross, He could remain "just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus" (Rom 3:26). The cross shows us that God does not overlook sin. He deals with it fully and righteously in His Son, Jesus Christ. John Stott says it well, "The cross is the only place where God's love and God's justice meet without contradiction."

God's justification is received by faith. "The righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ" is given "for all those who believe" (Rom 3:22). Faith is not mere agreement with facts. It is personal trust in the finished work of Christ. Paul reminds us that Abraham was justified by faith and not by works (Rom 4:3, 5). This is the heart of the gospel. The ground of our acceptance is not our spiritual record but the righteousness of Christ credited to us. As Paul states, Jesus "was delivered over because of our transgressions, and was raised because of our justification" (Rom 4:25). Easter assures us that His sacrifice was accepted and that our verdict of guilt has been removed.

The result of God's justification is peace: "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Rom 5:1). This peace is not merely a feeling. It is a restored relationship with the Creator. It is God's peace that enables Christians to endure in this world (John 16:33). Because "the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us" (Rom 5:5), the Christian can endure even suffering with hope. What a tremendous truth that God has reconciled us to Himself and restored peace with Him.

As we approach Easter, let this truth shape our hearts. If you are trusting in Christ, you are no longer under God's condemnation (Rom 8:1). You do not need to live as though you are still on trial before Him. You have been justified by grace. Rest in His final verdict. Let it humble you, because His salvation is entirely God's gift (Rom 3:24). Let it fill you with gratitude, because the blood of Christ purchased it (Rom 5:9). And if you have not yet placed your faith in Jesus, hear the gospel invitation in Scripture to "confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead" and if you do, "you will be saved" (Rom 10:9). The righteousness of God is offered freely to all who believe. This Easter, may we rejoice not only in an empty tomb, but in a secure salvation and a Savior who justifies sinners and grants them peace with God.
