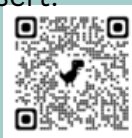
Wednesday Night DINNER

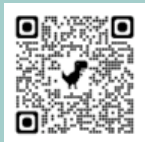

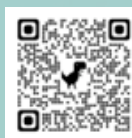
