We are reaching out to ask for your support as volunteers. VBS is only possible through your commitment and the grace of the Lord.

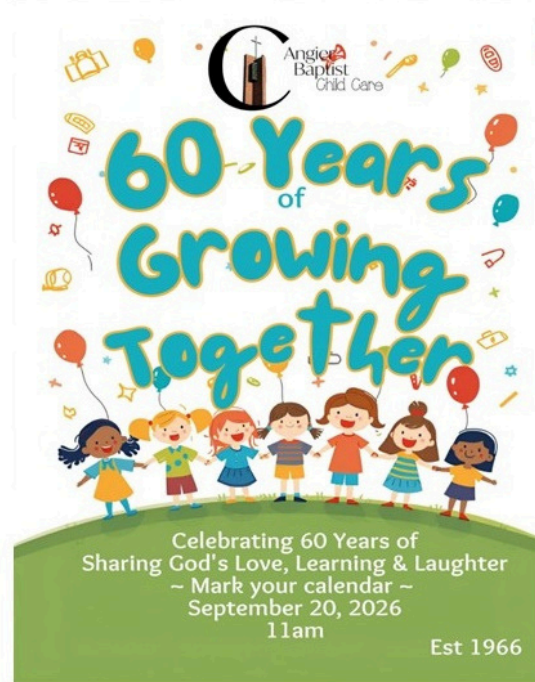
**Dates: July 19-23, 2026**
