1 Samuel 17:1-7

How can we be confident in the Lord when facing those things that seem too big to overcome? Sadly, many Christians live defeated and discouraged when God wants us to walk in His deliverance. In 1 Samuel 17 we reflect on a familiar story when the Lord gave David victory over Goliath and the Philistine army. As we look at David's response to battling a 9 foot giant, what can you learn from his courage and confidence? Why is it important to live boldly as a Christian today?

3 Observations of David's Commitment to Victory

- **Threats Against God's Army: 17:8-11; 16; 23-24**

- **Testimony of God's Deliverance: 17:34-37**

- **Triumph of God's Anointed: 17:40; 45; 47**

- ✓ In your prayer closet, thank God for the victory He has given you over sin and temptation.
