"HOLY WEEK" AT HP

INTERACTIVE DEVOTIONAL

First, we will provide an interactive devotional that will be in our Study Together messaging group on the HPTULSA app. Throughout the week and each day, we will post thoughts and details about what was happening around the same time during the last week of Jesus. 
