Primary Purpose:

The Director of Youth Ministry at Aldersgate Abilene Methodist Church seeks to extend the Kingdom of God through leadership in the ministry of the church; through the equipping of youth to become “Deeply Devoted Disciples Who Are Becoming, and Living, Like Jesus,” and through coordinating the efforts of the church in ministry to youth and their families.

Christian Commitment:

- Professes faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.
- Commitment to personal spiritual growth.
- Regular participation in a small group or Sunday School class.
- Regular participation in the worship services of Aldersgate Abilene Methodist Church.
- Regular participation in outreach and mission.
- Agreement with the doctrine of the Global Methodist Church.

Key Responsibilities:

- Lead weekly youth programming, to include Sunday School, Bible Study, and Youth Group.
- Recruit, schedule, and support volunteers; ensure all volunteers complete background checks and required child safety training.
- Create a discipleship pathway for students (gathering, growing, serving, leading).
- Partner with parents through consistent communication and opportunities for involvement.
- Coordinate youth events, mission/service projects, and fundraising.

- Track attendance/engagement trends and implement strategies to increase youth participation.

Expectations for each Staff Member

- Agreement with the doctrine of the Global Methodist Church
- Meet regularly with the Church Administrator.
- Participate in weekly staff meetings.
- Participate in the life of the church.
- Have the ability to maintain and keep confidences.
- Support the mission of the church.
- Model Christian behavior.
- Act in a professional manner.
- Engage in congregant care.
- Support other staff members and foster a healthy work environment.
- Any and all other responsibilities as assigned.

Ministry Wins:

- Increase youth participation and consistent student engagement.
- Students demonstrate spiritual growth and take steps into serving/leadership.
- Parents report strong communication and trust in the ministry.
