



(Colossians 1:9-14)



Colossians 1:9-11

- 9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;
- 10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;
- 11 Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

Colossians 1:12-14

12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: 13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: 14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

Paul informs the Colossians that he is praying that they will *be filled with the knowledge of his will* (1:9c).

filled: “to be controlled by” God’s will.

How can we be controlled by God’s will?

Do you want to be controlled by God’s will?



God has two kinds of wills for our lives

Moral / general will

For every believer

Specific will

To some degree is different for every believer

Finding God's specific will requires first being obedient to His *moral will* as revealed in the Bible, which has five requirements.

Walk Worthy

Wait Joyfully

Work Faithfully

Worship Thankfully

Withstand Mightily

I. WALK WORTHILY - Colossians 1:10a

10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord

- ❑ **Walk** – lifestyle or conduct
- ❑ **Worthy** - of equal weight

15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; 1 Peter 1:15

Having a high biblical knowledge, wisdom, and understanding leads to right living which is a holy life.

III. WITHSTAND MIGHTILY - Colossians 1:11a-c

11 Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

The result of increase in the knowledge of God's Word and will is power.

“As we do God's will, He strengthens us so we can withstand temptation and discouragement with endurance because of His glorious might and power.”



What does this mean?

EPHESIANS 3:16, 20

¹⁶ That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

²⁰ Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

3 REASONS TO WORSHIP THANKFULLY

- ✓ In Christ God has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints of light.
- ✓ God has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the Kingdom of His beloved Son.
- ✓ In Christ we have redemption , which is the forgiveness of sin.
