RE: Our Next Principal

Finding a worthy successor to Principal Kate Thielke has been the Board of Parochial Education's most critical task these last several months. Our search extended far and wide, we considered candidates from classical Lutheran school programs across the country as well as familiar faces right here at home. We prayed continuously. We asked for your prayers continuously. You responded. We were honored by the number of people who were willing to be considered for this important role and by your support and patience as we worked through this process. We are pleased to report that our process is now complete.

OSL's Board of Parochial Education has recommended that Mr. Erik Morrissey be named Our Savior Lutheran School's next Principal. Last night, OSL's Church Council approved that recommendation and we will now ask OSL's Voter's Assembly to call Mr. Morrissey as our next Principal!

Mr. Morrissey has served on our faculty for 26 years with distinction and excellence and currently heads our Logic School. One of the most essential responsibilities for any Principal is to be a "teacher of teachers," and Mr. Morrissey has long been recognized as one of our finest educators. He has the respect of his fellow faculty members as well as our school parents. It is difficult to find a more passionate advocate for classical education among the community of classical Lutheran schools across the country. Mr. Morrissey's devotion to the classical teaching of literature, language arts, and our Oratio program have become models for other classical schools. Finally, Mr. Morrissey's deep commitment to OSL's community gives us full confidence that he will execute the office of Principal with the same love, commitment, and purpose he has brought to his classroom for all these years.

Through the remainder of the school year, Mr. Morrissey will continue to fulfill his current classroom and coaching duties. Ms. Jeanene Lunsford, Mrs. Lynette Cherington and Mrs. Sarah Weider will continue in their interim positions as well, now working in consultation with Mr. Morrissey to establish the smoothest transition possible. Mr. Morrissey will formally take the Principal position on June 1st, 2026 and Ms. Lunsford and Mrs. Cherington will return to their Vice Principal roles.

Thank you for your patience, prayers, and support during the long process. The Board wants to express special thanks to Ms. Lunsford, Mrs. Cherington, and Mrs. Weider for the extra burdens they shouldered this semester in their interim positions. We would ask that you now direct that same encouragement and prayerful support to the Morrissey family as Erik takes on this new ministry in our congregation and school.

The Lenten Sketches

Dear Families of Our Savior Lutheran Church,

We are currently in the midst of sending enrollment offers to scholars whom we have prayerfully selected. Our admissions process is intentionally personal and thorough. Parents begin with a tour, scholars visit the school, and, depending on their age, may stay anywhere from 30 minutes to a full school day. Beginning in Kindergarten, scholars also complete an entrance exam at each grade level. Once these steps are complete, we pray and thoughtfully discern which scholar and family will be the best fit for our community. Serving families for Jesus Christ is our mission, and that mission guides every part of our admissions process as we consider each child and family individually.

You may have noticed in the church bulletin that we are seeking teachers for the upcoming school year. We are grateful to be growing and will be adding two additional early childhood classes for our 3- and 4-year-old age groups. This growth will allow us to triple the number of classes in Preschool, PreK, and Kindergarten. In addition, we will need Logic School teachers to support double classes from first through eighth grade.

Here are a few highlights from February:

- On February 3, our scholars participated in our annual Step-Up Day. Each grade level visited the classrooms and teachers of the next grade, giving them a sneak peek into what lies ahead next school year.
- Our Kindergarten, first, and second graders enjoyed a field trip to the George Theater to see *The Emperor's Disappearing Duds*, based on the classic fairytale *The Emperor's New Clothes*.
- Our fourth graders visited The Taste of Texas, where owner Nina Hendee shared unique Texas artifacts, memorabilia, and fascinating stories from our Lone Star State.
- We celebrated OSL Spirit Week from February 9–13 with special dress-up days, culminating in an all-school pep rally to send off our varsity girls' and boys' basketball teams to the LCMS State Basketball Tournament.
- We enjoyed a Winter Break in the middle of February, and even earned an extra day off after exceeding our annual fund goal by raising just over \$100,000! This extra day was enjoyed by both faculty and scholars.
- We closed out the month with our annual Go Texan Day celebrations. For our ECE and Kindergarten scholars, Mr. Pat Gavin shared old western songs and stories about life as a Texas cowboy. Our scholars also prepared special Go Texan Day songs to perform for their parents.

We are truly blessed at OSL to have the continued support of our church. Together in ministry, we are building God's kingdom.




Gather together, share a




