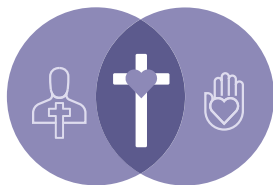

CONNECTING IDENTITY & CALLING

IDENTITY: WHO AM I?

God has called me into His family through Christ, who made me a fellow heir with Him in the kingdom of heaven.

CALLING: WHY AM I HERE?

I can live each day as God's called child, loving Him and serving my neighbor.

GROWING IN FAITH FOR LIFE

ADULT

I can draw connections between how Abraham was called by God and how we're called into God's story of salvation through Christ.

YOUTH

I can share that I am God's forgiven and beloved child, called to follow Him.

ELEMENTARY

I understand that I am God's child and that He calls me to follow Him.

EARLY CHILDHOOD

I know God calls me to be His child and promises to bless me.

I trust in You, O LORD.

SCRIPTURE SNAPSHOT

Abram responds to God's calling as he leaves his idolatry and homeland to follow the true God. Abram takes his wife, Sarai, and nephew Lot as they journey to the land of Canaan. The Lord's appearance prompts Abram to build an altar, celebrating God's promise to give this land to his descendants.

TAKING IT HOME

- ▶ *On the Go*—God blessed others through Abram because Abram was faithful to God. Think about ways you are a blessing to others because you believe in Jesus as your Savior.
- ▶ *At Mealtime*—God promised Abram that all nations would be blessed through him. God sent Jesus to fulfill that promise. How are all people blessed through Jesus?
- ▶ *Something to Do*—God told Abram to “number the stars.” Find a website with an interactive sky map and look at the planets and constellations visible in your area. Go stargazing together and see if you can spot any in the night sky.
- ▶ *Before Bed*—Pray together, asking the Holy Spirit to give you faith to walk each day, trusting in God.
