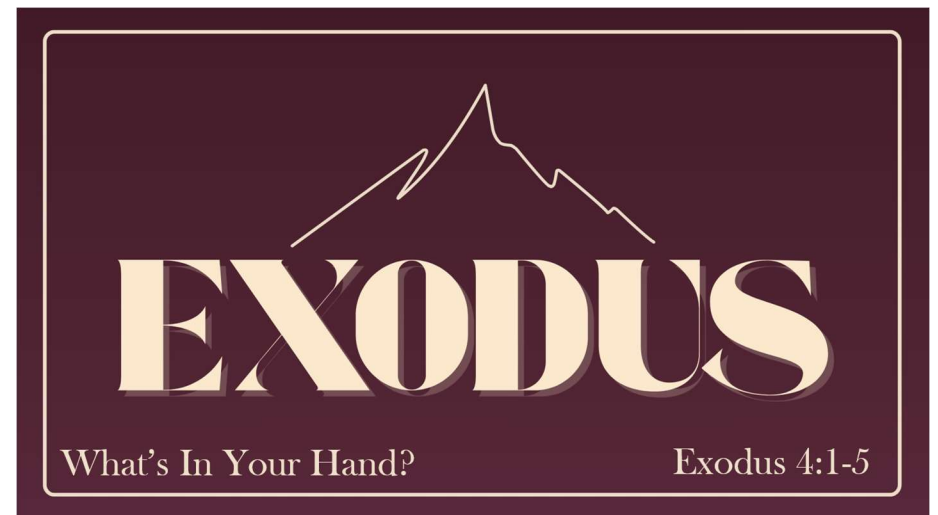


Sermon Discussion Points for

First

Read Exodus 4:1-5. Exodus chapters 3-4 contain the dialogue between God and Moses as God speaks to him from the burning bush. God unveils His calling for Moses to lead the people of Israel out of slavery in Egypt. Moses is reluctant. Through a series of objections, God persuades Moses to obey the calling God gives him.

Intro

1. What three people would you say have had the greatest impact on the course of human history?
2. Who have been the most important influences in your life, those who have helped most significantly in making you the person you are today?
3. How did they “do” that? What was it about them that had that influence?

Exodus 3:1-4

1. What was Moses doing when God appeared to him at the burning bush?
2. What lesson are we to take from God appearing to Moses as a burning bush?
3. Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-29. Why does God choose and use “the common?”

Exodus 4:1-5

1. Why do you think Moses was so reluctant to rise to God’s call?
2. Can you identify with that sense of reluctance? — a hesitation to fully embrace what God is calling you to?
3. What does God ask Moses in verse 2? What was the answer?
4. Why did God ask Moses that question, since God already knew the answer?
5. What did Moses learn about God from this encounter?
6. What did Moses learn about himself from this encounter?
7. Most importantly, what are WE to learn from this encounter?
8. What is in YOUR hand that God can use to accomplish your assignment?
9. Name the resources God has placed in your possession that can be used to advance His Kingdom.
