

# LIFE GROUP LESSON

I AM • Week of May 28

## Introduction:

What is it like to visit a new vacation spot? When was the last time you tried a new restaurant? Perhaps you have made a new friend recently. Share with the group an experience that comes to mind when you actually tried something new, or began spending time with a new friend.

We are people of habits and often find ourselves going to the same restaurants, the same vacation destination; we tend to hang around familiar friends. Launching out into something new is challenging. Jesus actually said, "Behold I have come to make all things new" (Revelation 21:5). Our Scripture today is from John's Gospel. We will also read about how God birthed something new when He birthed His Church.

Before reading the text ask these questions:

1. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you?
2. What could you possibly do about what the Holy Spirit is saying?
3. How can we (as a Life Group) help each other live into what the Holy Spirit is saying?

**Read Text: John 14: 1-6**

Jesus has three important distinctions in the "I Am" sayings here. Let's name them:

Closing in prayer: We may not have 10 days to devote to praying in an upper room, yet we pray for each other now! How can we pray for Christ Church to be faithful to the mission of God as shared in Acts 2?
