Well, I know I don't have much pull, but I am dubbing the next three months the Summer of Wisdom! Won't you join me?

On May 24th we began a series on the book of Proverbs that will carry us through the summer. I am excited to see where it takes us. One thing is certain, it must begin with the fear of the Lord. So, I invite you to put God in His proper place this summer as we look to Him as our ultimate authority, the maker of heaven and earth. He is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords and He is our Savior; our only hope for a future and our guide to living out the Way of Wisdom here and now.

Know this, we are continually being tempted in our flesh to do things our own way – this has been true from the beginning in the garden, when Eve saw that the fruit of the forbidden tree looked “good for food and was a delight to the eyes AND that the tree was to be desired *to make one wise*, she took of its fruit and ate...” Likewise, Proverbs 14:12 tells us, “There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death.”

It is fair to say we have good reason to pursue *chokmah*, the Hebrew word for godly wisdom, through which we might live well in God's world! Thus, the Proverbs tell us not only to begin with the fear of the Lord but also in Proverbs 3:7 not to be wise in our own eyes! Instead, the wise father of Proverbs exhorts us to, “Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and He will make straight your paths.” We are surrounded by a culture that seeks to be wise in their own eyes – June is a perfect example as our culture has sought to dub it as “Pride Month.” This is not God's Way, not the *chokmah* through which He has created our world. This is man's wisdom. Scripture is clear, man's wisdom is, in reality, folly.

So, this summer, let us commit ourselves anew to putting God in the driver's seat, let **Him** establish His ways in our hearts that we might be given knowledge and given the opportunity to apply that knowledge to wise living, and that we might enjoy a Summer of Wisdom.

What a great mindset for the dads among us as we strive to be men worthy of honoring this Father's Day!

From the mouth of Jesus when He lived on earth:

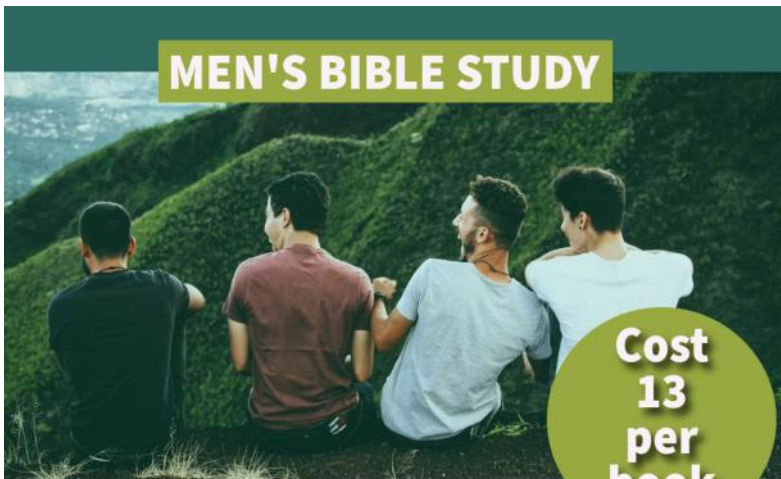
