The 2022 Fall Upward Flag Football & Cheer Season has been underway since September 12th and it has been going well. This season we have 289 football players and 32 cheerleaders participating. Each team has one, one hour practice per week. This season we have 8 teams practicing on Monday evenings, 8 teams practicing on Tuesday evenings and 8 teams practicing on Thursday evenings for a total of 24 teams in this year's league. As the season progresses we take water breaks at practice to talk with players and parents about how they matter to God and Biblical virtues such as kindness and compassion. On the field they are learning how to listen to their coaches, be good team

players, and even learning how to navigate disagreements with teammates at times.

There are many moving pieces that make a Saturday Upward Game Day happen. We work hard to make sure that it is a good experience for our kids and families that are participating. Here is what a typical gameday looks like: Field Set Up takes place from 7:30-8:30am with a team setting up the football fields for players and parents. This season there are three hours of football games—8:30am, 9:45am & 11:00am. During the game we have Northsiders who welcome people to the Upward Field and help them find the area where their child or grandchild is playing. Following the games, a Field Break Down Team helps to get all of the football gear back into the Upward Field Red Barn. Before they leave they ensure that our field is clean and ready for its next use. There's still time for you to help out in any area you would like to as we make this a great experience for the players, cheerleaders, and parents alike. Be in prayer for Upward for the next two weeks. Pastor Dave has been helping those in attendance know that they matter to God and toward the end of the season he will encourage them, if they have not already made Jesus the leader of their life, to do so.


Of course you can pack your own box and bring it by the church. We will deliver them with our boxes.


ECCLESIA NIGHT OF WORSHIP


