God gave Lori the opportunity to serve as the Executive Director and Board Chairperson for the local crisis pregnancy center as well as many opportunities to serve outside the US with Life International as an International Training Specialist. Lori continues to serve the Pro-life movement in different capacities with over 25 years of experience.

While in Cleveland, OH their grown, married children (who stayed in California) started to have children of their own so they started transitioning to the West Coast in a town called Livermore, CA outside of San Francisco where they thought they would retire. But what is unique about the Swanson family is they all decided to leave the San Francisco area and relocate to Charlotte.

Their daughter, Nichole, is married and lives with her husband, Chad, and their three children in Wesley-Chapel, NC. Their son, Seth, and his wife Sharolitt have five children and live in Rock Hill, SC. Both
