## Faith Built to Last: Brick by Brick in Christ

**“Do you not know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? Therefore we were buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. (Romans 6:3-5)**

On Easter morning and all the Sundays of the Easter Season, we joyously celebrate Jesus’ resurrection and his triumph over sin and death. We also rejoice in the power of “newness” – the gift of new life in Jesus Christ.

Christians have always found unique ways to celebrate newness of life. In ancient times, newly baptized Christians would wear white robes to signify their new life as followers of Jesus. In a similar way, Christians today often wear new Easter clothes to represent how we put on Christ and his resurrection.

On Easter Sunday morning, the glorious light of Christ shines bright as our sanctuary is alive with Easter blooms. We joyfully sing the “alleluias,” which we put away on the last Sunday before Easter. The dust and ashes of Lent are washed away with the precious blood of Jesus, and God’s people experience renewal on the most holy day of the church year.

FLAME is currently exploring:

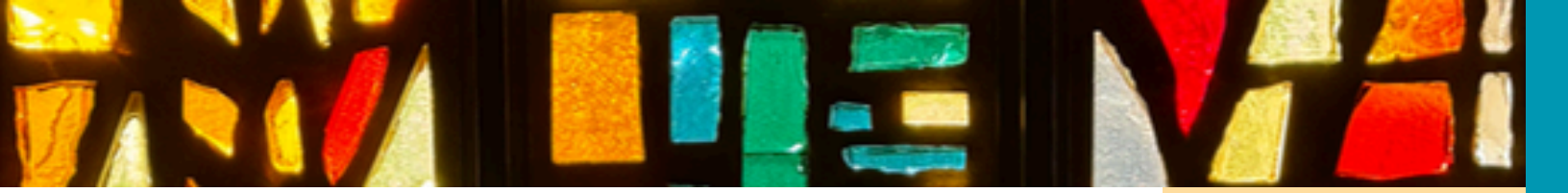
- The Crucifixion Was Not on Friday

## Treasurer's Report

General giving for February 2026 was \$27,904, compared to \$33,780 for 2025 and \$29,082 for 2024. The February general giving was \$2,221 higher than the budgeted amount for general giving. Income exceeded expenses by \$3,004 for February.

Year-to-date income exceeds expenses by \$3,546. Year-to-date income is higher than budget by \$1,370, expenses are lower than budget by \$2,489, and interest earnings are lower than budget by \$47, resulting in net income that is \$3,812 higher than budgeted.

# Mission Team Updates

## Facilities Management Team

CHAIR PAM JOHNSON

### Highlights

- Water usage within the church was elevated; replacement toilet flappers have been installed, and usage levels have since normalized.
- Several electrical updates—specifically outlet work in the Sanctuary and garage—are currently on hold and scheduled to resume in April.
- Repairs to the previously broken water pipe have been completed, with only painting remaining.
- Options for cleaning the window wells are currently under evaluation.
- Two new water leaks occurred in the Upper Room toward the end of the month due to snow and wind conditions; a roofing contractor has been notified, and the issue has been identified as snow accumulation around roof vents.

### Building Accident Update

On Thursday evening March 26th, a community organization held their regular meeting at our church. One of the participants parked their car in the handicapped space by the Free Little Pantry. She thought she had her foot on the brake pedal but pressed the accelerator instead.

Thankfully, she was not injured. However, you can see that there was damage to the building.

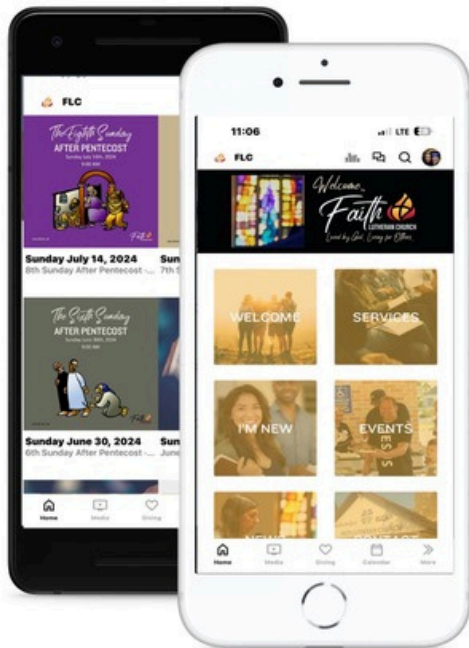
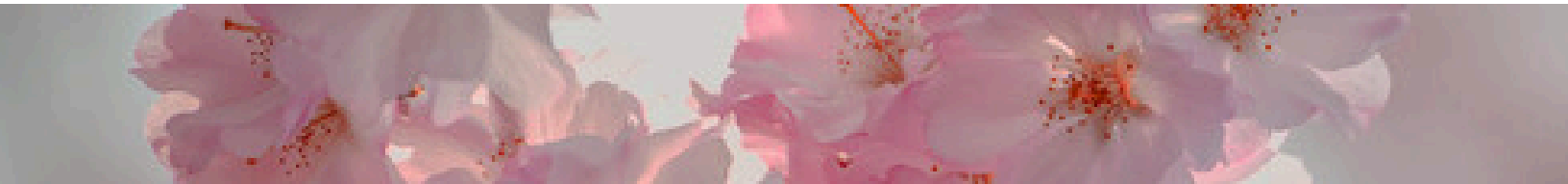
