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Built Together in Faith

So then, you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone; in him the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling place for God. (Ephesians 2:19-20)

Dear People of God,

For our Lenten program earlier this year, we adopted the theme “Brick by Brick in 2026.” Each week during Lent we used a brick saved from the parsonage to highlight five important features of our discipleship. We focused on the “Five Bricks of Faith” -- Holy Hospitality, Sharing Our Sacred Stories, Simply Serving, Persistent Praying and Grateful Giving.

All five of these Bricks of Faith have been central to Faith Lutheran’s ministry in 2026 as we have built upon the foundation of those who came before us. We have carried forth the vision of the people who established Faith Lutheran Church in 1954, and built the “holy temple” at 207 Cherry Ave, which is our church home.

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As individuals who have answered God's call, we continually strive to deepen our relationship with Jesus Christ. Yet as we read in Ephesians 2, we aren't just following Jesus by ourselves. Instead, we are "no longer strangers and aliens" but "members of the household of God." We are all joined together as one body with Jesus as our cornerstone. We grow in faith by connecting with other members of the body of Christ. For this reason, active church participation and fellowship with other believers is essential to our faith journey.

This fall, there will be new opportunities for us to get to know each other better and grow in faith together. Watch for sign-up sheets in the Gathering Area and consider joining in one (or more) of the activities below. Please sign-up to indicate your interest and you will be contacted.

- Men's Group – Are there any men who are interested in getting together once-a-month for breakfast and/or Bible study?
- German Baking – Last year we had a successful Scandinavian Baking event on a Saturday morning that was led by three Faith Lutheran members. This year we have had a request to try a German Baking event. (Black Forest Chocolate Cake or Feffernuts, anyone?)
- Dinner Groups – For the past 2 years, we have had several "Dinner for 8" groups meet periodically for food, fellowship and reflection. In fact, some are still meeting! This is an opportunity to meet fellow worshippers in a relaxed setting and make new friends.

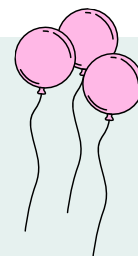

What an incredible week!

From July 25–31, 19 youth and adults from Faith Lutheran Church and our partner group from First Presbyterian Church traveled to Indianapolis, Indiana, for our 2026 Mission Trip with YouthWorks. While every mission trip has its challenges, it also creates opportunities for growth, service, laughter, new friendships, and memories that stay with us long after we return home.

Throughout the week, our group served in several different settings, including food pantries, clothing ministries, gardens, and other community organizations.

We also had opportunities to experience Indianapolis together, including visiting the Indianapolis Dunes, enjoying Greek food, participating in a meaningful foot-washing experience, and spending time getting to know one another.

Some of the favorite experiences shared by our youth included:

- The Dunes
- Holy Family Shelter
- Mary Riggs
- Hope Center
- Thursday evening Greek food and foot washing
- Serving alongside others in the Indianapolis community

But perhaps the greatest part of the trip was seeing our youth step outside of their comfort zones and discover that serving others isn't always about doing something huge.

What Did We Learn?

One of the most valuable parts of a mission trip happens after we return home. We asked our youth to reflect honestly on their experience, including what they enjoyed, what challenged them, and what they learned. Some of the challenges they identified included:

- Speaking with people they didn't know
- Meeting new people
- Working through situations that were different from what they had experienced on previous mission trips

Not every part of a mission trip is easy — and that is part of the point. Faith grows when we are willing to step outside what is comfortable. We are thankful for the honesty of our youth and the opportunity to continue learning from this experience as we look toward future mission trips.

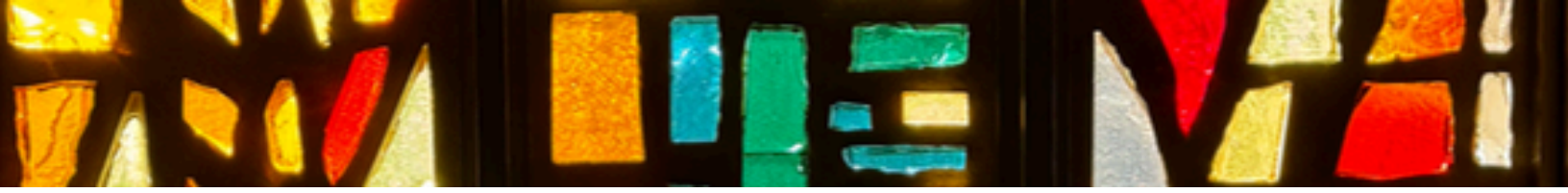
FLY Advisory Team

Treasurer's Report

FROM TREASURER KENT MUELLER

General giving for July 2026 was \$19,373, compared to \$22,351 for 2025 and \$20,051 for 2024. The July general giving was \$6,310 lower than the budgeted amount for general giving. Expenses exceeded income by \$2,031 for July.

Year-to-date income exceeded expenses by \$3,962. Year-to-date income is lower than budget by \$10,304, expenses are lower than budget by \$13,938, and interest earnings are higher than budget by \$145, resulting in net income that is \$3,779 higher than budgeted.

The approved 2026 budget anticipated breaking even for the year, so the financial performance is currently exceeding expectations, primarily due to expenses being lower than budgeted.

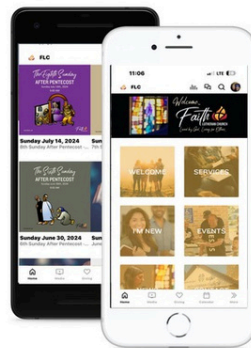

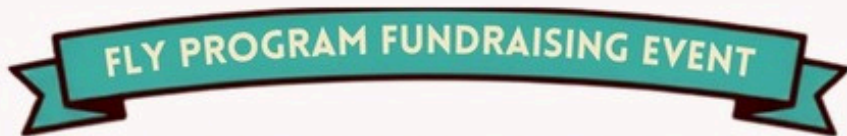
