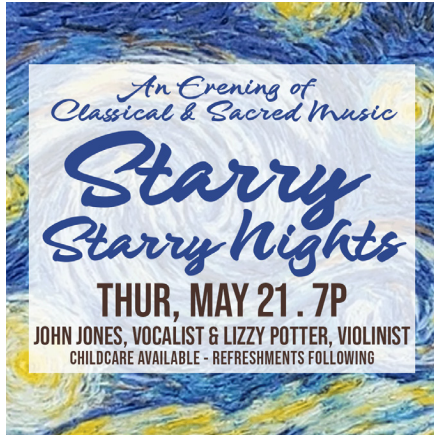

Help us send kids from Adams, Hoover & OnFire to Outreach Camp in June! Scan the QR to give safely online.



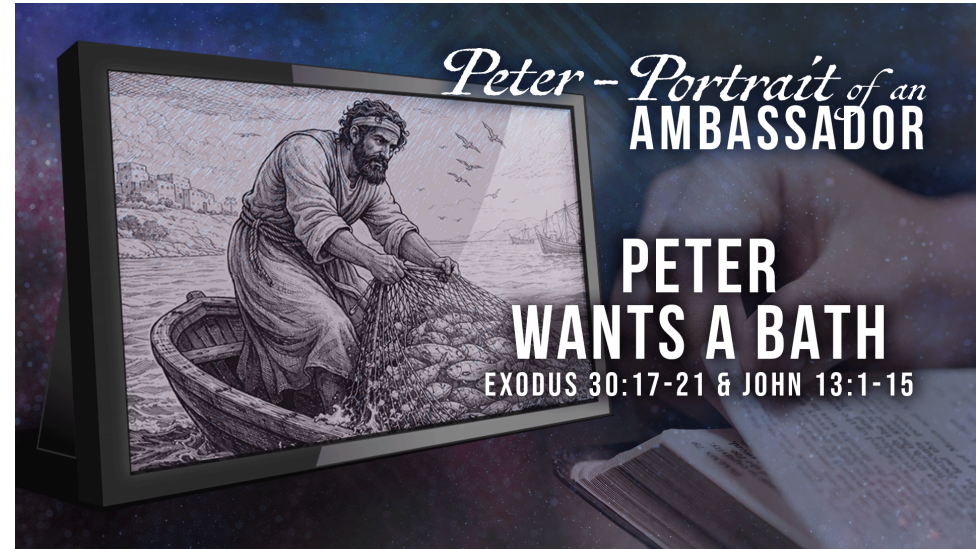
New to QR Codes? Give it a try!

WELCOME TO GRACE!

We're jumping back to Holy Week to talk about yet another time when Peter is bold enough to state his confusion. The gospel of John does not include the Last Supper, instead, it includes this event where Jesus washes his disciples' feet. Why? John wants to be sure that his readers understand baptism and its relationship to the kingdom. Why should we care? Peter comes to understand that life in Jesus' kingdom involves getting his feet dirty, but that the dirt does not corrupt him. This is the mode of being an ambassador: washed to be in the household, getting dirty in the world, and washing one another in service.

“Peter Wants a Bath”

Scripture: Exodus 30:17-21, John 13:1-15

STUDY QUESTIONS

Introduction: Dirty Feet

Foundation 1: Jesus Washes Us Clean from the World

1. Peter can't imagine the king of kings washing his feet. Yet this is the foundation of his kingdom. While we might be used to this idea, what is Peter's challenge of understanding here?

Foundation 2: Ambassadors Need Regular Cleaning

2. What's the difference between a full bath and a footwashing? What does Jesus mean that Peter is already clean but needs his feet washed?

Foundation 3: Ambassadors Must Serve

3. Why does Jesus set this example and why is it important? The service is not just helping one another, it is actively sustaining each other in the household of God.

Implication (So what?): Baptism is entry to the family, establishing a life of service, supported by the church family

4. What does baptism mean? Why is it important for the church?

Application (Now What?): Wash one another's feet

5. Who could you help sustain as they go into the world? Who could sustain you?

SERMON PRAYER

Baptism is a solemn event in which the power and stain of the power at work in the world - the power of sin and death - is washed away in Jesus. Let us pray that we sustain and renew our baptisms for one another as we boldly go into the world.
