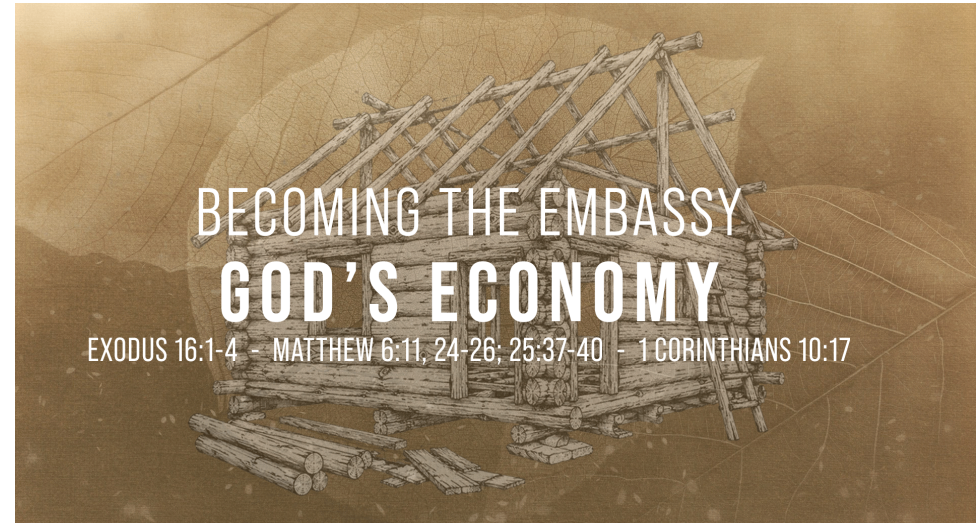
New to QR Codes? Give it a try!

Exodus 16:1-4; Matthew 6:11, 24-26; 25:37-40; 1 Corinthians 10:17

STUDY QUESTIONS

Introduction: Domestication and Food

FOUNDATIONS (WHAT?)

Foundation 1: A Food Theology Overview

Food supply is a major theme throughout the Bible. What are some of the food highlights from the sermon? Can you think of others we didn't mention?

Foundation 2: Food Shows Sovereignty

What's the connection between authority (sovereignty), provisions, and providence (looking after provisions)?

Foundation 3: Food Reveals the Character of the House

Jesus contrasts the rule of the world and the kingdom of God, what are some contrasts you see between the economy of mammon (stuff) and the economy of God?

IMPLICATION (SO WHAT?)

A Jesus-Shaped Community Feeds Each Other

Jesus is the "bread of life." His "body is food." We are "the body of Christ." Connecting body and bread, as Paul does in 1 Cor 10:17, shows that the food economy of the kingdom is fully connected to being the body of Christ.

APPLICATION (NOW WHAT?)

Restarting a local Economy

We are considering food, the importance of food, but also how we can give rest through food, rather than just asking for volunteer cooks... How could we connect food to fostering community?

PRAYER

Let us pray that God would supply our daily bread, that we could become the body of Christ, the bread that is the life of the world. Pray for wisdom in discerning how to connect food with events and with relationships.
