How can I reflect Christ today!

SEEK GOD FIRST

Malkuta is an ancient Aramaic word that means Kingdom. It is most famously used in the Aramaic Biblical Passages of the New Testament as the original word behind the phrase "Kingdom of God" or "Kingdom of Heaven".

Dynamic Action: Represents God's power and mercy breaking into the daily world to heal and restore, rather than a far-off place. [1, 2, 3, 4]

Malkuta (also spelled *malkutha* or *malkut*) is an Aramaic and Hebrew word that translates to, rather than a physical territory. [1, 2, 3]

Jesus' real name in Aramaic and Hebrew was, which means "salvation" or "the Lord saves".

Living by the Spirit, Living the Spirit life!

John 6:63 AMP

It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh conveys no benefit [it is of no account]. The words I have spoken to you are spirit and life [providing eternal life].

1 John 4:17 YLT

In this made perfect hath been the love with us, that boldness we may have in the day of the judgment, because even as He is, we -- we also are in this world;

God Is a Spirit!

John 4:23-24 AMPC

A time will come, however, indeed it is already here, when the true (genuine) worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth (reality); for the Father is seeking just such people as these as His worshipers. [24] God is a Spirit (a spiritual Being) and those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth (reality).

If the Holy Spirit is God and God is the Holy Spirit?

Then the Holy Spirit is eternal, that lives in you. That makes you live eternally, now!

1 Thessalonians 5:23 BSB

Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely, and may your entire spirit, soul, and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

GIVING THANKS BEFORE BREAKTHROUGHS! Sowing before the harvest! Tithes

2 Chronicles 20:20-22 KJV

And they rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; Believe in the Lord your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper. [21] And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the Lord, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the Lord; for his mercy endureth forever. [22] And when they began to sing and to praise, the Lord set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

TODAH!

Open your mouth and declare God, I see you and recognize you are here and has already released the provisions, healing - I receive it now in Jesus name by faith in His name!

Ask, Seek and Knock

Luke 11:9-10 AMP

“So I say to you, ask and keep on asking, and it will be given to you; seek and keep on seeking, and you will find; knock and keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you. [10] For everyone who keeps on asking [persistently], receives; and he who keeps on seeking [persistently], finds; and to him who keeps on knocking [persistently], the door will be opened.

Prayer is beyond asking God to meet your needs, its pursuing the relationship with the Father.

By Asking, Seeking and Knocking, we enter the three phases of relationship.

QUSHU

Qushu" is written in Arabic as **خشوع** (pronounced *Khushū'*). It means deep humility, submissiveness, and focused concentration—especially the calm, quiet state of the heart and body when a person stands in prayer before God.

The Divine Nature!

2 Peter 1:1-4 KJV

Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: [2] Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, [3] According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: [4] Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Born of the Spirit!

John 3:3-8 KJV

Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. [4] Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? [5] Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. [6] That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. [7] Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. [8] The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

The recreated spirit!

2 Corinthians 5:17 KJV

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

Living in Power!

Luke 10:17-20 KJV

And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. [18] And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. [19] Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. [20]

Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

Living consecrated!

Romans 8:5-11 AMP

For those who are living according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh [which gratify the body], but those who are living according to the Spirit, [set their minds on] the things of the Spirit [His will and purpose]. [6] Now the mind of the flesh is death [both now and forever—because it pursues sin]; but the mind of the Spirit is life and peace [the spiritual well-being that comes from walking with God—both now and forever]; [7] the mind of the flesh [with its sinful pursuits] is actively hostile to God. It does not submit itself to God's law, since it cannot, [8] and those who are in the flesh [living a life that caters to sinful appetites and impulses] cannot please God. [9] However, you are not [living] in the flesh [controlled by the sinful nature] but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God lives in you [directing and guiding you]. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him [and is not a child of God]. [10] If Christ lives in you, though your [natural] body is dead because of sin, your spirit is alive because of righteousness [which He provides]. [11] And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you.
