## Monday

**Ramazan & Shamsia:** Pray for faithfulness during the long process of working on expositional books (James, Titus, 1 and 2 Timothy, and Galatians). Pray that we do the translation accurately because the Farsi speaking churches greatly need these resources.

**Ramy & Ruba:** Pray as God leads.

**Ric & Frieda:** I (Ric) just returned from a ministry to Colombia. Pray for their country's presidential elections in May. Some polls say the likely candidate to win is Ivan Cepeda, a self-declared communist, whose father was a guerrilla leader. His intention is to lead the country to become a future Cuba/Venezuela communist nation. Also, pray for the Cuba/USA talks. Cuba is in a crisis and this is an opportunity for the 67-year communist regime on the island to allow some changes for the people that don't have medicine, food, electricity, fuel, etc. The folks that we work with on the western side of the island are managing the crisis better than most folks, since we have provided solar energy and basic needs for those in our training center.

## Tuesday

**Richard & Amanda:** Pray as God leads.

**Rick & Kim:** We are going on our first trip to our new area of Manacapuru with a group of doctors and dentists. Pray for the details, logistics, and for the love of Jesus be shown to everyone.

**Ryan & Erica:** Praise that we have five people considering serving with El Refugio full-time. Pray for wisdom and discernment in this process, and for Ryan as he prepares El Refugio's budget for next year. Pray for our kids, that they will grow in their faith in Jesus.

## Wednesday

**Sam & Amanda:** We really need your prayers that our house would finally be done. It has been a big struggle these last months - the builder has taken on other jobs and since then he seems to have lost interest in finishing our house. Sam has taken on a lot of extra work himself - even making several trips to Namibia for materials. Pray with us that all would be completed and we can move in!

**Shannon:** Thank God for His sustaining grace while I have been "on the road to resurrection" among Romanian and international churches, and communities in Europe. Pray for Elvin, a friend and leader in the growing Iranian church in Bucharest, for recovery from a serious car accident last month with his wife Claudia. Ask that their testimony will draw attention to their most important relationship, based on receiving by faith new life in Christ.

**Sheila:** Pray for wisdom for our ISTELE executive committee (of which I am a member) as we seek to implement some very critical changes in staffing and
