Tim & Jenn: Praise God for His care for our family, our church, and the country we're living in throughout the war in the

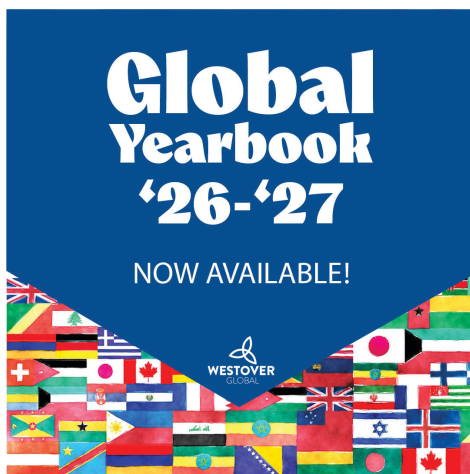
