Melinda and I will be participating in a trauma healing training course in a couple of weeks.

Stirling & Donna: Praise the Lord for funding for several projects at Tchincombe. We ask continued prayers for a visa for Jeffrey and Bree.

Tim & Jenn: Praise God for the men and women of our church involved in Bible

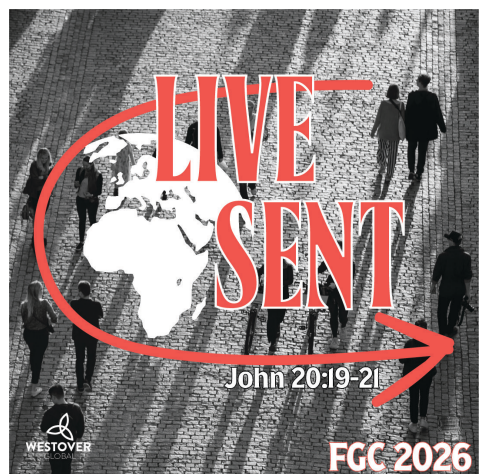
