Impact and Fuse invited a former college athlete, Doug Elks, to come and share with students on Super Bowl Sunday. Doug shared part of his own testimony and challenged students to think about the idols in their own lives. At the end of his time sharing, he presented the Gospel and gave students an opportunity to personally respond and asked if anyone wanted to invite Jesus to be their Lord and Savior. Several students stood up indicating that they wanted to put their faith and trust in Jesus Christ. On January 4th, we kicked off the year gathered as a church family in one service. SERVING AT WESTOVER



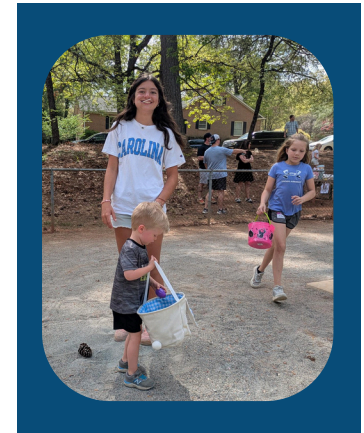
Garden Day
