"Let Us Love and Sing and Wonder"

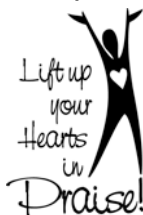

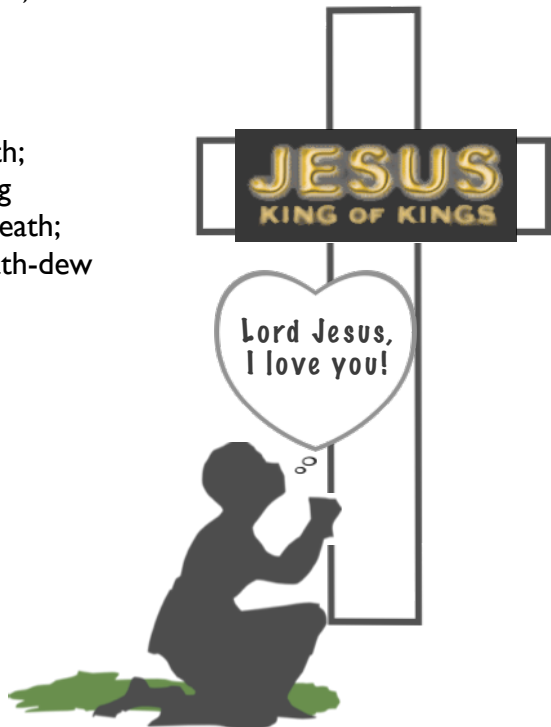
"My Jesus, I Love Thee"

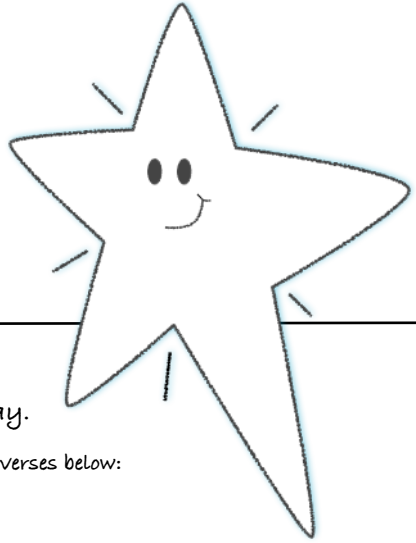
