



Calvary Family,

It brings me great joy to give you some updates concerning our Calvary 90 Project. In 2025, our Calvary family began the Calvary 90 Project. Phase One, which included the remodel of our gymnasium, was completed in the summer of 2025. Since then, our Ad-Hoc committee has been working on Phase Two and Phase Three of the project. These two phases consist of removing our Music Building, completely redesigning our main South parking lot, creating two new playgrounds, building an access road from the West side of our campus, and much more. Over the last several months our Calvary 90 Ad-Hoc, along with Finance and Stewardship Committees have been meeting to pray and discuss the final details of this project. We have done our best to keep our church family updated as we have had information to share and we are now ready for the final presentation.

As you continue to pray, mark these dates on your calendar:

**Sunday, Oct. 18 | 21-Days of Prayer and Fasting**

We will begin 21-Days of Prayer and Fasting. This project is a step of faith. A 21-Day devotional will be provided around the first of October to help prepare for this emphasis.

**Sunday, Nov. 1 at 6:00p.m. | Calvary 90 Final Presentation**

During this presentation, final drawings and financial numbers will be presented.

**Saturday-Sunday, Nov. 7-8 | 24-hour Day of Prayer**

Beginning on Saturday, Nov. 7 at 7:00a.m., you will have the opportunity to come to the church sanctuary to pray for our Calvary 90 Project. For 24 straight hours, all through the night, someone will be in our sanctuary praying to our Heavenly Father. Sign-ups for each 30-minute time slot will begin soon.

**Sunday, Nov. 8 | Calvary 90 Day of Giving**

Our 21-Days of Prayer and Fasting will end on this day. This is a BIG Day! Sunday school will meet as normal. Our worship time will be a different type of service. Our entire worship service will be centered on prayer, worship, Scripture reading, and giving. We ask that each church member, as you are led by the Lord, bring a sacrificial gift on this day to be given towards our Calvary 90 Project. During this service, you will have the opportunity to bring this gift to the altar.

Please note: This special day is a *Worship Service*. Jesus will be exalted throughout the whole service.

**Sunday, Nov. 15 - Calvary 90 Project Vote**

At the conclusion of the morning worship service, our Calvary 90 Ad-Hoc Committee, along with Finance and Stewardship Committees, will present a motion for church approval.

Please review a list of questions and answers below:

***Could this timeline change?***

Yes, we believe this timeline is accurate; this is a major project. If any of our committees need more



time, we will allow for that. We will keep you updated should any of these dates change.

***Will any of the final drawings be available prior to the Nov. 1 presentation?***

Yes, it is our desire to provide final drawings to the church a few weeks before the presentation.

***How much will this project cost?***

Our final numbers are currently being considered. Previous estimates had this project in the \$4–6 million range.

***When will the final costs be shared with our church family?***

Final costs will be shared on Sunday, Nov. 1.

***On our Day of Giving, will everything given go towards the Calvary 90 Project?***

You will have the opportunity, as normal, to give your regular tithe and offering in our offering boxes. Gifts for the Calvary 90 Project will take place during a special time of the worship service. Additional instructions on how to give on this day (by mail or online) will be given as we get closer to this special Day of Giving.

***Can I just give my normal tithe/offering to the Calvary 90 Project Day of Giving?***

We encourage that any gift given on this special day be *above* your normal tithe and offering. Our 2026 budget year ends on Dec. 31. Historically, a large percentage of our budget is given in the last quarter. As a result, we will need a *strong* last quarter to meet our 2026 budget.

***What if I am not able to give on Nov. 8?***

Our Nov. 8 Worship Service will be just that, a Worship Service. If you are unable to give that day, you will still be able to commit to a time of prayer during this service for our Calvary 90 Project.

***Will the vote on Nov. 15 be to complete the whole project or will we divide this project in phases?***

This question will be answered after our Calvary 90 Day of Giving. Naturally, it will be less expensive to complete the whole project at one time and not in phases. However, it will all depend on what is given on Nov. 8.

***Do we have a Calvary 90 Project Day of Giving goal?***

Our stewardship committee discussed this question in detail. We do not want to limit what the Lord can do. So, no specific goal will be shared except for what the entire project is currently estimated at \$4–6 million.

The Lord's hand has been evident among our church family. Recently, we have seen people saved and new families join Calvary. Sunday school and Worship Service attendance has been higher than recent years. There is a sweet, unified breath of the Spirit of God among our church family. The timing of this project is perfect. Let's continue to pray and be vigilant as we look to the Lord and prepare for an exciting October and November.
