STUDENTS

Parent Night - Parent Night is a monthly gathering for the parents of students at Calvary. This meeting takes place on the youth floor and is designed to give parents insight into the student ministry schedule and activities, as well as provide resources for family discipleship.

Prayer Breakfast - A time every Monday morning throughout the school year for students to pray and fellowship. We meet at 6:45AM at Jack's to lift up prayer requests for our families, friends, and community.

D-NOW Weekend - D-Now is a weekend early in the year (normally January) that involves gathering as a youth group for the purpose of growing our fellowship with Christ, one-another, and our youth group, as well as, gathering with other youth groups from Lee County for corporate times of worship.

Super Bowl Party - Our Super Bowl Party is a time of fellowship during the Super Bowl each year. There is food, fellowship, and a short devotion during halftime.

Senior Dinner - This is an evening in late April where we honor our highschool seniors and their families. We gather for a meal on the youth floorn to honor and celebrate each senior.

Senior Sunday - Senior Sunday is a time in May where we honor the seniors during a Sunday morning corporate worship service, giving them a Bible and recognizing them.

Summer Camp - A week in the summer (normally June) where we travel and gather with other churches for a time of worship, fellowship, recreation, and intentional spiritual growth. Cost is normally less than \$300 for the week.

Super Summer - Super Summer is a leadership conference hosted by the Mississippi Baptist Convention that takes place at Mississippi College in Clinton, MS each year on the second week of July. During the school year, students work to meet requirements. At Super Summer, students study leadership, evangelism, apologetics, and discipleship with other youth leaders from across the state.

The Great Senior Challenge - Starting in August, the seniors in the youth group will compete for points throughout the school year. They will be awarded points based on their attendance, leadership, and winning various challenges throughout the year. The seniors with the highest points are rewarded in May.

Fall Retreat - Each November, students gather for a weekend of worship and intentional fellowship. Unlike D-NOW, Summer Camp, and Super Summer, we do fall retreat as an individual youth group, rather than with other churches. The goal is to grow in unity.

Christmas Party - Each December, students gather for games, fellowship, and a time of Bible Study to celebrate the Christmas season and the reason for Christmas—Jesus!

Student Leadership Team - This is a group of students who have a desire to grow their leadership abilities and their influence among the youth ministry at Calvary. These students go through an application process and commit to being held accountable for things like church attendance and participation. This is a great opportunity for teenagers looking to grow into stronger leaders.
